Gonzales County has made an ongoing commitment to provide services in a nondiscriminatory manner for individuals with disabilities, Gonzales County conducted an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) and Section 504 Self-Evaluation. The Gonzales County ADA contact, Misty Cook, did the evaluations and below are the findings:

### **Buildings**

1. Gonzales County Courthouse is ADA compliant,
2. Randle Rather Building is ADA compliant,
3. Office of Emergency Management is ADA compliant,
4. Gonzales County Precinct 3 is ADA compliant,
5. Gonzales County Precinct 4 is ADA compliant, and
6. Courthouse Annex Building is being built as of 03.2026 (building should be complete by the end of 2026)

### **Transition Plan for Buildings**

Gonzales County plans to have Building Maintenance keep up with the buildings and to let Misty Cook, the ADA Contact, know if any of our buildings need repairs to keep them ADA compliant. Once the Courthouse Annex Building is complete the County Judge, Commissioners, and Building Maintenance will inspect the building to make sure that we are ADA compliant.

### **Transition Plan Updates and Completion Dates for Buildings**

Our goal is to keep up with the buildings and make sure they are staying ADA compliant on a regular basis. Building Maintenance will alert us if they see anything that needs repairs or updates to the buildings. The Courthouse Annex Building is being built ADA compliant and Gonzales County Judge, Commissioners, and Building Maintenance is getting updates from the builder and once the building is near completion, which should be before the end of this year, they will take a tour with the builder to make sure everything is complete.

## **Website**

Gonzales County website needs some upgrades done to it.

### **Transition Plan for Website**

Gonzales County plans to update the Website. We are currently working with CIRA on a renewed contract to update our Website. We are also working on getting our Grievance Procedure, ADA Nondiscrimination Policy Statement, Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 Assurance, Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 Nondiscrimination Statement, and the Gonzales County ADA Policy added to our Gonzales County website. We already have on the website Gonzales County ADA Discrimination Complaint Form and Procedures.

### **Transition Plan Updates and Completion Dates for Website**

Gonzales County is working with CIRA to get our website updated to the latest version. As of right now we are having to wait until our new budget sets in which is October 2026 in order to have the funds to update the website. After the new budget takes place then the County Judge Office will coordinate with CIRA to get the updates done. We will start the migration part of updating our website with CIRA after we have gotten it approved in Commissioners Court on 03.23.2026. Once approved then in October of 2026 when our budget takes effect we will get with CIRA to start the process. I have been told that CIRA will have it updated sometime in 2027 but I don't have a date as of right now to when it will be done. We will have on the website the Coordinator information, ADA Plan, Grievance Procedures, and Compliant forms on the website. I am working on getting them translated to Spanish should have the information on the website by May 2026.

## **County Roads**

Gonzales County roads do have the reflective signage and are found to be ADA compliant.

### **Transition Plan for County Roads**

Gonzales County Commissioners and Road Workers will continue to make sure our signage is in good condition and are reflective.

### **Transition Plan Updates and Completion Dates for County Roads**

Gonzales County Commissioners and Road Workers are continuously fixing roads and signage as they are needed. They check the roads and road signs and also the community calls the Commissioners or calls their clerk to report anything that needs to be done. The community also tells the road workers as they are working in different areas if they notice something on another road.

Services

Gonzales County services such as Court Hearings, Communications, and such are found to be ADA compliant.

Transition Plan for Services

Gonzales County will continue to make sure the services we offer are ADA compliant. For example, our Court Hearings we will make every attempt to offer, upon request, translators, sign language, hearing impair help, and any other request that might come in. Gonzales County also offers a service called "Hyper Reach" which is a service that has weather alerts which can be found on our website with a "Scan Me" so each community member can access the app and they can also text "Alerts" to a phone number to get the service. Gonzales County also holds their Commissioner Court meetings in person and online for the residents to access.

Transition Plan Updates and Completion Dates for Services

Gonzales County will continue to evaluate our services regularly to make sure that we are staying ADA compliant. If a problem or concern comes up from a community member we will make sure that it is addressed in a timely manner.
