

The Jail Admin stated they have contacted their vendor, who will be on site next week to make the necessary repairs to the door indicators. The Inspector reminded the Jail Admin that the door indicators shall be operational at all times for safety and security reasons. <u>Follow-up Required-Within 30 days, the Jail Admin will send the Inspector confirmation that they have fixed the issues observed with the door indicators.</u>
