# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN BOWIE COUNTY AND MAUD INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT COOPERATION

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is made by and between the Bowie County Sheriff's Office ("BCSO") and the Maud Independent School District Police Department ("MISDPD").

WHEREAS the Texas Education Code Section 37.081 requires a school district police department and the law enforcement agencies with which it has overlapping jurisdiction to enter into a memorandum of understanding that outlines reasonable communication and coordination of efforts between the department and the agencies:

WHEREAS the parties acknowledge that they share overlapping and concurrent jurisdiction and agree to provide each other mutual aid and assistance within such overlapping jurisdictions in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Agreement;

WHEREAS this document shall serve as the MOU addressing the requirements of Section 37.081 of the Texas Education Code and the intentions of the parties;

WHEREAS Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS Bowie County ("County"), Texas is a corporate and political body and a local government entity as set forth in Texas Government Code § 791.003 (4); and

WHEREAS the Bowie Independent School District ("MISD") is a Texas school district and local governmental entity as set forth in Texas Government Code § 791.003; and

WHEREAS the parties, in performing governmental functions or in paying for the performance of governmental functions hereunder shall make that performance, or those payments, if any from current revenues legally available to each party.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the promises and mutual covenants herein contained, under the authority of Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Gode and Chapter 37.081 of the Texas Education Code, the parties agree as follows:

#### Article 1 - Mutual Aid

BCSO and MISDPD will have concurrent jurisdiction over MISD Property (as that term is defined herein below) within the County limits and extra territorial jurisdiction of the City of Maud, TX. BCSO and MISDPD may provide each other mutual aid within their concurrent jurisdictions, subject to availability of personnel and prioritization of competing needs for aid. With respect to matters within their concurrent and overlapping jurisdictions, BCSO and MISDPD may act as back-up for each other and may assist each other in investigations, crowd control, and crime scene control. The MISDPD shall answer all calls to service involving

MISD Property and buildings during regular school hours and may request assistance from the BCSO.

#### Article 2 - MISDPD Jurisdiction

- 1) MISDPD shall have primary jurisdiction of and over MISD property, including real and personal property located inside and outside the boundaries of MISD that is owned, leased, rented, or otherwise under the control of MISD, except that BCSO shall have jurisdiction over any property owned by Bowie County which MISD has leased, rented, borrowed, or otherwise used. Additionally, BCSO shall have full concurrent jurisdiction with MISDPD in the event any MISD vehicle or bus is involved in an accident of any sort or any other violation of laws of the State of Texas governing movement and operation of vehicles which occurs within the limits or extra-territorial jurisdiction of Bowie County.
- 2) The jurisdiction of MISDPD set forth above shall be concurrent and overlapping with that of the BCSO. MISDPD has primary responsibility as first responder and over all offenses which occur on any MISD Property during regular school hours, and BCSO may assist MISDPD when requested by MISDPD. BCSO may transfer an initial report taken by BCSO to MISDPD during non-regular school hours that did not require immediate action. MISDPD will also have jurisdiction and authority to pursue, arrest, apprehend, and investigate within the geographical boundaries of Bowie County and the MISD when such action is related to or arising from an act, incident; or crime occurring within or involving MISD Property.
- 3) MISDPD shall also be responsible for public safety matters relating to traffic and operation of motor vehicles to the extent necessary for MISD events occurring on any MISD Property, including but not limited to sporting events, and shall coordinate all regulations of such traffic and operation of motor vehicles with BCSO in advance. Except as otherwise set out herein, MISDPD shall also have primary responsibility as first responder over any incidents involving a MISD vehicle or bus used to transport MISD students, faculty, and administration and all vehicles and buses of any transportation contractor of MISD used in connection with such contractor's services provided to MISD during regular school hours.

#### Article 3 - MISDPD Officer Duties

MISDPD's peace officer's duties shall include the duty to protect the safety and welfare of any person, including but not limited to students, faculty, administrative personnel, and all other persons within MISDPD's jurisdiction as set forth above and the duty to protect MISD Property wherever situated during regular school hours. BCSO officers may assist MISDPD officers when requested.

#### Article 4 -Offense Reports

MISDPD shall prepare and shall be responsible for all Offense reports and case reports in matters in which MISDPD has primary jurisdiction during regular school hours as described in Article 2. Offense reports and arrest reports completed by the BCSO for matters arising on or in connection with MISD property shall be referred to MISDPD for follow up. MISDPD shall

furnish any and all reports requested by BCSO. Nothing in this paragraph is intended to prevent BCSO from preparing offense reports and case reports in matters where MISDPD has primary jurisdiction in accordance with the applicable rules, procedures, and regulations to which BCSO is subject.

#### Article 6 - Communication

BCSO and the MISDPD shall notify each other of all activities, violations, arrests, and other matters as may be required under Texas Code of Criminal Procedure, Art. 15.27 and other applicable provisions of Texas law including but not limited to the Texas Education Code.

BCSO and MISDPD shall coordinate radio frequencies pursuant to the regulations of the Federal Communications Commission and the designated frequency coordination organization (AASHTO), and agree on radio type, mode, and emission to enable interoperability. MISDPD may request use of BCSO radio channels until such time as MISDPD can license and acquire its own channels and frequencies. Such permission shall not be unreasonably denied.

Any notice required or permitted to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be delivered or sent by certified mail, postage prepaid, as set forth below:

If BCSO: Jeff Neal, Sheriff Bowie County Sheriff's Office 100 N, Stateline Ave Texarkana, TX 75501

If MISDPD: Joe L. Rochelle, Chief Maud ISD Police Department 389 Houston St. Maud, TX 75567

#### Article 7 - Conduct

The BCSO and MISDPD shall endeavor to conduct their dealings with each other in a courteous, professional, cooperative, and amicable manner so that the citizens and persons within their concurrent jurisdiction will be better served and protected.

#### Article 8 - Term

This MOU shall automatically renew annually on the anniversary of the effective date each year, unless notice is provided by either party that the MOU will not be renewed. Either party may terminate this MOU for any reason with seven days' notice to the other party.

#### Article 9 - Termination

MISDPD and BCSO shall make their best good faith efforts to work together as understood and set out in this memorandum. This agreement may be terminated by either party at any time, with or without cause, by a party providing thirty (30) days written notice of such termination to the other party, subject to Texas Education Code 37.081(g) which requires a school district police department and the law enforcement agencies with which it has overlapping jurisdiction to enter a memorandum of understanding outlining reasonable communication and coordination efforts between the department and the agency. Upon termination, BCSO shall continue to take any and all necessary actions to provide safety, security, and other law enforcement duties to the people within the territorial limits of Bowie County. Notice, for the purpose of termination shall be to the County Judge and the Bowie County Sheriff, and to the MISD Superintendent and MISDPD Chief of Police.

#### Article 10 - Entire Agreement

This Agreement contains the entire contract between the parties hereto, and each party acknowledges that neither has made (either directly or through any agent or representative) any representation or agreement in connection with this Agreement not specifically set forth herein. This Agreement may be modified or amended only by agreement in writing executed by the parties hereto, and not otherwise.

#### Article 11 - Immunities

Nothing in this Agreement is intended to and County does not hereby waive, release or relinquish any right to assert any of the defenses County enjoys by virtue of the State or Federal Constitution, laws, rules or regulations, and any sovereign, official or qualified immunity available to County as to any claim or action of any person, entity, or individual against County.

#### Article 12 - Nondiscrimination

Company/Contractor/Vendor, including subcontractors, assignees, and successors in interest, ensures that no person shall on the grounds of race, religion, color, national origin, sex, age, disability, or any other protected class under law, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination or retaliation in any federally or non-federally funded program or activity when providing any services described herein under this contract/agreement.

#### Article 13 - Additional Documents

The parties hereto covenant and agree that they will execute each such other and further instruments and documents as are or may become necessary or convenient to effectuate and carry out the terms of this contract/agreement.
