
Call to Order.

Comments must be pertinent to an agenda item or an area for which the Court has jurisdiction. The total allocated time is 30 minutes for all comments.

3. Consider and take action to declare April as Child Abuse Prevention Month.
4. Consider and take action to proclaim May as Community Action Month.
