Interlocal Cooperation Agreement

Levy, Collection, and Apportionment of Certain TABC Fees Affected by Texas Health & Safety Code Section 437.01235

This Interlocal Cooperation Agreement ("Agreement") is made by and between the City of Texarkana, Texas ("City"), and the County of Bowie, Texas ("County").

WHEREAS, effective September 1, 2025, Texas Health & Safety Code Section 437.01235, as amended by S.B. No. 1008, will read as follows:

Notwithstanding any other law, a county, municipality, or public health district, including an authorized agent, employee, or department, may not charge a fee under Section 11.38 or 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code, if the premises is a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment that has already paid a fee to operate to the department or to any county, municipality, or public health district.

WHEREAS, both City and County have authority within their respective jurisdictions under Sections 11.38 and 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code, to levy and collect fees for permits and licenses issued, subject to statutory limitations.

where we county by interlocal agreement created a public health district that neither charges nor has been authorized to charge a fee under Section 11.38 or 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code.

WHEREAS, since the amended Section 437.01235 of the Texas Health & Safety Code creates a "first to bill" dynamic between cities, counties, and public health districts if the levied fee pertains to "premises [of] a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment", City and County intend by this Agreement to provide clarity for affected businesses and prevent duplicate billing, with City levying and collecting certain fees within City's jurisdiction and remitting forty percent (40%) of such collected

fees to County.

WHEREAS, nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to govern fees that are not specifically detailed or referenced in Texas Health & Safety Code Section 437.01235.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code, City and County agree as follows:

Article I. City Covenants

- 1.1 For any premises within the corporate limits of City that is either a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment, City shall continue to levy and collect a fee authorized under Section 11.38 and 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- 1.2 In consideration of County's covenants in Article II of this Agreement, City shall remit to County, within a reasonable time after the end of City's fiscal year, forty percent (40%) of fees described in paragraph 1.1 of this Agreement that are collected within said fiscal year.

Article II. County Covenants

- 2.1 In consideration of City's covenants in Article I of this Agreement, for any premises within the corporate limits of City that is either a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment, County shall not levy any fee authorized under Section 11.38 or 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code.
- 2.2 County affirms that City retaining sixty percent (60%) of fees described in paragraph 1.1 of this Agreement and collected within a given fiscal year is a reasonable percentage as to fairly compensate City for the services or functions performed hereunder (that is, City's established administrative process and workload for levying, collecting, accounting, apportioning, or remitting fees governed by this Agreement).

Article III. Fees Not Levied by Health District

City and County affirm that their public health district created by interlocal agreement shall neither charge nor be authorized to charge a fee under Section 11.38 or 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code.

Article IV. Fees Not Governed by this Agreement

Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to govern levy or collection of fees with respect to premises within the corporate limits of the City that are *neither* a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment.

Article IV. Term and Termination; Conditional Renewal

This Agreement becomes effective retroactive to September 1, 2025. Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving the other party written notice of not less than ninety (90) days prior to the date of termination. This Agreement shall terminate August 31, 2027. In the event of no change in law affecting fees governed by this Agreement, the City Manager of City and County Judge of County shall be authorized, but not required, to renew this Agreement for an additional term of two years, extending the termination date to August 31, 2029.

Article V. General Provisions

A. Merger; Construction; Amendment; Severability.

This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties with respect to levy and collection of a fee under Section 11.38 or 61.36, Alcoholic Beverage Code, if the premises is within the corporate limits of the City and is either a food service establishment, retail food store, mobile food unit, roadside food vendor, or temporary food service establishment; and this Agreement supersedes all prior proposals, representations, communications, negotiations, and agreements

between the parties, whether oral or written, pertaining to such a fee. In construing this Agreement, neither of the parties hereto shall have any term or provision, or any uncertainty or ambiguity as to any provisions herein, construed against such party solely by reason of such party having drafted the same. This Agreement may be amended only by written instrument duly authorized by the governing bodies of each party and executed by the City Manager and County Judge. If any part of this Agreement is determined by any legal authority with jurisdiction to be beyond the power of either City or County, or invalid or illegal in any respect, this Agreement shall be modified accordingly; but if any such part is material to this Agreement, the Agreement may be terminated immediately by either party.

B. Notices

All notices required or permitted hereunder shall be in writing and shall be delivered to the following:

C. Non-Waiver

Failure of either party to insist on the strict performance of any provision of this Agreement or to exercise any rights or remedies accruing hereunder upon default or failure of performance shall not be considered a waiver of the right to insist on, and to enforce by any appropriate remedy, strict compliance with any other obligation hereunder or to exercise any other right or remedy occurring as a result of any future default or failure of performance.

D. No Personal Liability / No Waiver of Immunity

This Agreement does not create any personal liability on the part of any officer, agent, delegate, or employee of City or County. No party hereto waives or relinquishes any immunity or

defense on behalf of itself, its elected officials, officers, employees, delegates, and agents because of the execution of this Agreement and performance of the covenants contained herein.

E. Representations

By execution of this Agreement, each party represents to the other that:

- 1. In performing its duties and obligations hereunder, it will be carrying out one or more governmental functions or services which it is authorized to perform;
- 2. Each of the undersigned has been properly authorized by the respective party to execute this Agreement and that any necessary resolutions extending such authority have been duly passed and are now in effect; and
- 3. All payments required to be made by City to County will be made from current revenues available to City; and City and County affirm that such amounts retained as to fairly compensate City for the services or functions performed hereunder.

This agency originated in 1964 as the Episcopal Adult Services of Bowie County and the name of the organization was changed to Senior Citizens Services of Texarkana, Inc. in 1966. During the month of August 2025, the total of both congregate and home delivered meals we served in Bowie County was 7,433. We also served a combined total of 856 meals at the congregate sites in Bowie County.

There are 3 different home delivered meal programs -- One of them is for those aged 60+ and the other 3 programs are for those aged 18+. Both ages must be homebound and cannot come to the congregate sites. If they have a home health nurse who comes to their home and checks on them, this meets the criteria for homebound. If they receive HDMs it not only gives the participant a well-balanced, nutritious meal but also gives them the assurance that someone will be checking on them every delivery day. The drivers are trained to recognize signs that something is not right and to report this to the proper people to obtain help for that individual.

The meals are delivered between 11:00 am & 1:30 pm and the participant, or in some cases, the caregiver must be home to receive the meal. We cannot leave them in an ice chest, outside refrigerator, etc.

If anyone is interested in applying for the congregate meal program or the home delivered meal program, please have them contact Senior Citizens Services at (903) 831-7696 and we will be happy to assist them.

As you are aware these programs would not be possible without funding and we are hopeful that Bowie County will again enter into an agreement with our agency to allow us to obtain a Texans Feeding Texans Grant. This requires the county to contribute \$0.25 for every person who is aged 60+ on the 2020 census $(21,355 \times $0.25 = $5,338.75)$ which is the same amount as last year.

2025-2026 State Crisis Intervention Grant Program

WHEREAS, The Bowie County Commissioners Court finds it is in the best interest of the citizens of Bowie County that the State Crisis Intervention Grant Program be operated for years 2025-2026.

WHEREAS, Bowie County Commissioner's Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Office of Governor funds, Bowie County Commissioner's Court assures that the funds will be returned to the Office of Governor in full.

WHEREAS, Bowie County Commissioner's Court designates the County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Bowie County Commissioner's Court approves submission of the Grant application for State Crisis Intervention Grant Program to the Office of the Governor.
