**GENERAL ORDER** 

The Court having considered the requirements of Tex. Rules Civ. Froc. §§ 21c,

and Tex. Family Code §§ 105.006 & 108.001, among other rules and statutes, finds that sensitive data is often required to be filed pursuant to Texas Rules and Statutes; and the Courts finding that sensitive data often contains information that publically disclosed could result in confidential information becoming public information. The parties, their attorneys, the Court and District Clerk's office personnel are hereby authorized to review the un-redacted pleading. Any pleading containing un-redacted sensitive data submitted for filing in accordance with the Texas Rule of Civil Procedure or Texas statutes, where no identical, second redacted pleading has also been filed, shall not be sealed as set forth herein until an identical, second redacted version of the pleading has been submitted for filing.
