AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GRAND SALINE, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2025-101 ORDERING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 3, 2025, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR AND TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR A TWO YEAR TERM

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY or GRAND SALINE:

To Elect a Mayor. Shall be for a two (2) year term

To Elect two (2) City Council members. Each of the two positions shall be for a two (2) year term.

The current positions are held by Councilmember Leah Erwin, and Councilmember Brandi Morris. Mayor position is vacant due to resignation of Mayor Ridge Tardy

The first day to file for a place on the General Election Ballot is Wednesday, January 15, 2025, and the last day to file for a place on the general election ballot will be Friday, February 14, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. The last day for a write-in candidate to declare candidacy will be Tuesday, February 18, 2025, by 5:00 p.m.

The first day to accept applications for voting by mail ballot will be Saturday, January 1, 2025. The last day to receive an application by mail for a ballot to be voted by mail, is April 22, 2025.

First Day of Early Voting by Personal Appearance will begin Tuesday, April 22, 2025, thru Friday April 25, 2025 then Monday April 28, 2025 thru Tuesday April 29, 2025, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day. Early voting will be located at: GRAND SALINE INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT, 400 STADIUM DRIVE, GRAND SALINE, TEXAS.

Election day is May 3, 2025. Polls will open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 7:00 p.m. at:
