And the meeting being called to order at 3:08 p.m., Judge Newsom, Chairman of the Hopkins County Bail Bond Board, presided over this organizational meeting, whereupon the following resolutions were duly adopted upon motion made, seconded and unanimously carried, to wit:

**I. The Hopkins County Bail Bond Board to Discuss and/or Take Appropriate Action on The Request for Release of Security, Real Property, For Texas Bail Bond #1.**

(1) Ms. Fulcher reported that her office showed that there is one criminal case that has been pending since November 2012. The defendant has been mentally committed and the bond was issued in the amount of \$10,000.00 in a felony case. She suggested maybe talking to Judge Northcutt to see what actions needs to be taken on the pending case. In addition, Ms. Fulcher also stated that there were nine NISI cases pending for Texas Bail Bond #1. After a brief discussion between Amanda and the clerks, Judge Newsom made the announcement that action could not be taken since there is a pending felony case and NISI cases. Cindy Horton made a motion to approve the release of collateral only if and when the collateral is replaced with cash. The motion was not carried to vote because of the pending cases and instead will be placed on the next regular quarterly agenda.

**II. The Hopkins County Bail Bond Board to Take Comments from the Public and Discuss Future Agenda Items.**


(1) No items were presented for discussion.

**V. Bail Bond Board to Adjourn.**

(1) There being no further business to discuss, a motion to adjourn was made by Judge Ginn and seconded by Cindy Horton. Motion was called to a vote and carried unanimously. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned by Judge Newsom at 2:21 p.m.
