

EXPUNCTIONS PROCEDURES IN ANDERSON COUNTY

This list is required to be published by the district clerk of the county pursuant to Senate Bill 1667, passed during the 89th session, effective 9/1/25.

The following is a list of agencies normally involved in the expunction process. Please include the physical or mailing and emailing address of each agency in your petition.

Duplicate agencies will not be notified. **No “issue expunction-certified mail fee is required if you include the agency’s email addresses in the petition and order.**

This list is not all-inclusive. You should include any outside agency that has published your information concerning the charge and arrest. For each agency you include **that does not have a email address, must pay \$25.00** for the ‘issue expunction-certified mail fee, which includes mailing of the notice and the order.
