The Mortgagee now asserts the right to be equitably subrogated to all rights and priorities of the taxing authority as a result of paying the ad valorem taxes, as it was contractually authorized by the Mortgagor to do. The Mortgagee does not intend to merge its equitable subrogation lien rights with the lien of the Deed of Trust and it expressly reserves all of its rights to assert the equitable subrogation lien.


