### CONTINUATION OF DECLARATION OF DISASTER

**WHEREAS**, the Hardin County Commissioners' Court met in Regular Session at 10:00AM on February 13, 2018, at the Hardin County Courthouse, Commissioners' Courtroom, located in Kountze, Texas; and

**WHEREAS**, The County of Hardin, Texas, on the 25<sup>TH</sup> day of August, 2017, was in imminent threat of the occurrence of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property resulting from severe weather conditions countywide created by torrential rainfalls, severe thunderstorms, high speed winds, and flash flooding over an extensive period of time posed by Hurricane Harvey. Since that time, populated areas of Hardin County have been affected by flooding and major infrastructure damage has been sustained, preventing access to or safe passage on many roadways, thus creating a public safety hazard; and

**WHEREAS**, the Commissioners Court of Hardin County, Texas has determined that extraordinary measures are necessary to protect or rehabilitate property, and are hereby ordered.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS:**

- I. That a local state of disaster was declared by the Hardin County Judge on August 25, 2017, pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code; and continued by Commissioners' Court on December 19, 2017, pursuant to Section 418.108(b).
- II. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, This State of Disaster shall continue for a period of not more than **sixty (60)** days from the date of this Declaration unless continued or renewed by the Hardin County Commissioners Court.
- III. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of a Local Disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Hardin County Clerk.
- IV. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this Declaration of a Local State of Disaster activates the Hardin Emergency Management Plan.
- V. This Proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
