

**PROCLAMATION**  
**DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER**

WHEREAS, the County of Blanco on this 2nd day of March, 2025 has experienced significant fire outbreaks causing property damage and threat of injury and loss of life and;


WHEREAS, forecasted weather and wind conditions for the coming days increases and exacerbates these conditions to the point that there is an imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property and;


WHEREAS, the Judge of the County of Blanco has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect and alleviate the suffering of citizens and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE JUDGE OF THE COUNTY OF BLANCO under § 418.108 of the Texas Government Code;

1. That a state of disaster is declared for the County of Blanco.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan is to be implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Blanco, Texas.
4. That all available County resources may be dedicated to relief efforts relating to this disaster and;
5. That a burn ban, consistent with this Proclamation, shall immediately issue and;
6. That this proclamation is to take effect immediately from and after issuance.
