

RESOLUTION CREATING A COUNTY HOTEL TAX

Whereas the BLANCO County Commissioners Court is authorized pursuant to Texas Tax Code, Chapter 352 to impose a Hotel Occupancy Tax, and

Whereas the provisions of said law allows for the adoption of said tax on a person who, under a lease, concession, permit, right of access, license, contract, or agreement, pays for the use or possession or for the right to the use or possession of a room that is in a hotel, costs \$2 or more each day, and is ordinarily used for sleeping, and


Whereas the BLANCO County Hotel Occupancy Tax shall apply to all hotels located within the county that are not subject to municipal hotel occupancy, and

Whereas said hotel subject to the BLANCO County Hotel Occupancy Tax shall account and collect said occupancy tax at a time and on a form prescribed by BLANCO County and shall remit said tax and report to the BLANCO County Treasurer, and

Now, therefore, be it RESOLVED that the BLANCO County Commissioners Court does hereby adopt and impose a Hotel Occupancy Tax effective April 1st, 2024, and collection shall begin on that date, and BLANCO COUNTY may pursue all penalties and remedies available under the law; and


Be it further RESOLVED that the tax rate shall be SEVEN percent (7%) of the price paid for a room in a hotel.


