## NOTICE TO PERSON FILING CIVIL OR SMALL CLAIMS ACTIONS & CROSS ACTIONS

The person filing a petition is totally responsible for deciding and stating who to sue and where to serve them. Court personnel do NOT take part in that decision. This is the only information you should receive from the Court office about that subject. No other questions will be answered. If you need legal advice beyond this you will have to do your own research or consult an attorney. Assumed name records are kept in each county clerk's office, and corporation records are kept by the Texas Secretary of State in Austin.

If the <u>named defendant</u> (the entity you want to sue) is <u>not</u> a <u>person</u>, but is a "DBA" (ex: "Southside Café"), a partnership (ABC, Inc.") OR SOME OTHER NON-PERSON ENTITY YOU SHOULD SUE THE <u>ENTITY</u> IN THE RIGHT NAME AND SERVE THE <u>RIGHT REPRESENTATIVE</u> OF THAT ENTITY IN ORDERS TO HAVE THEM PROPERLY IN COURT. If you don't do this, you may have your case delayed or dismissed. Meanwhile, the statute of limitations on your claim could expire against the right party if they are not sued in time.

You should avoid suing "everyone" just to make sure you get the right one. By signing a petition, you certify to the court that you have read the petition, and that to the best of your knowledge, information, and belief, formed after reasonable inquiry the petition is not groundless and brought in bad faith or groundless and brought for the purpose of harassment. Violation of this requirement can result in contempt of court or other sanctions.

You will be charged a citation and service fee for <u>each</u> and <u>every</u> name (person or non-person) you list as a defendant in the suit, <u>unless</u> they are named <u>only</u> as a registered agent of another defendant. For example:

"John Doe and Mary Smith" - 2 citations

"John and Mary Doe" - 2 citations

"Bill Doe and his father, John Doe" - 2 citations

"Southside Café, John Doe" - 2 citations

"John Doe d.b.a. Southside Café" – 1 citation

"Southside Café, owner John Doe" – 1 citation if you file it as a "d.b.a.", but if you are wrong you may not get a judgment.

"ABC Corporation, John Doe" - 2 citations

"ABC Corporation, John Doe as Registered Agent" – 1 citation

DO NOT try to explain your claim to the clerk and ask who you should sue. You must make the decision. And do not waste too much of your time or the clerk's time explaining all the details of the case. Save that for trial. DO bring 2 extra copies of all documents to the trial (1 for the court and 1 for the other party). If the clerk has to make additional copies during the trial you will be charged for those copies (\$1.00 for 1<sup>st</sup> page and .25 cents each page thereafter).

THIS FORM MUST BE READ AND SIGNED BY THE FILING PERSON AND PUT IN THE FILE BEFORE THE JUDGE WILL SIGN A CITATION.
