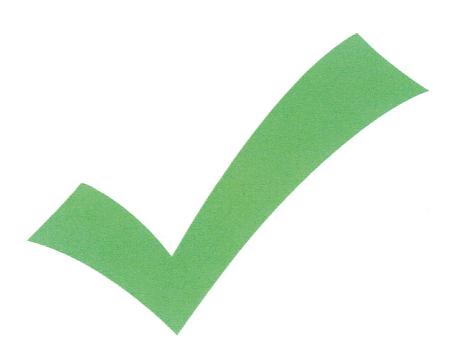

RELEVANCE

Texas A&M AgriLife Extension's Family and Community Health unit helps Texans better their lives through science-based educational programs designed to improve the overall health and wellness of individuals, families, and communities. The goal of Family and Community Health programs is to encourage lifelong health and well-being for every person, every family, and every community.

The Blanco County Family and Community Health In Depth program focused on topics related to exercise and physical activity and general well-being.

2022 State of Health in Blanco County

- 10% of adults report being in fair or poor health
- 27% of adults report no leisure-time physical activity
- 4.4 days were reported as the average number of days per month that adults feel mentally unhealthy
- 35% of adult residents are obese
- 34 cardiovascular deaths occured

Increased physical activity and improved eating habits have been associated with a greater ability to manage the complications of certain chronic diseases and delay the onset of the disease in individuals at risk. As a response, AgriLife has developed healthy lifestyle programs that can address these issues with an evidence-based approach through education.

In Blanco County Family and Community Health programming is led by County Extension Agent, Gretchen Sanders. In 2022, Assistant Extension Agent-Family & Community Health, Casey Sullivan, joined the Blanco County team and began leading programming in the area of health.

RESPONSE

The Blanco County Family and Community Health program area committee met three times during 2022 to plan and access opportunities for Family and Community Health Outreach programming. Thirteen contacts were established through these meetings. As a result of the committee's guidance, Walk Across Texas! was implemented. WAT! is an eight-week community program delivered through a web-based platform to help people of various ages and abilities establish the habit of regular physical activity. The WAT! program was supported and promoted by Gem of the Hills Senior Activity Center and the City of Blanco.

As part of the Family and Community Health Outreach plan, the County Agent works with other community agencies to foster collaborative partnerships. To prioritize this goal, Gretchen Sanders serves on the following local boards:

- Blanco County Community Resource Center
- Blanco ISD School Health Advisory Council, Co-Chair
- Blanco Municipal Wheels and Feet Committee Member
- Methodist Healthcare Ministries Health Committee Member

Additionally, Agent Sanders continued to grow her subject matter expertise and general knowledge of health through professional development trainings throughout 2022.



EVALUATION STRATEGY

Walk Across Texas! mileage is entered weekly into the Howdy Health website management system by individuals, team captains, teachers, and/or volunteers.

RESULTS

2022 Walk Across Texas Physical Fitness Challenge:

All Blanco County residents were invited to participate in the team challenge to increase physical activity. Change in behavior was used to evaluate the Walk Across Texas program.

- 7 teams participated with 51 adult participants
- 9,145 total miles logged
- 2022 Economic Impact of Walk Across Texas program:
 - o Diabetes Savings- \$181,020
 - o Cardiovascular Disease Savings- \$253,705
 - Total Economic Impact for Blanco County- \$424,725

SUMMARY

Through expansion of delivery methods, we have learned to utilize technology which merge traditional education with digital options. This allows us to promote numerous out of county educational events in addition to those developed and delivered in Blanco County.

FUTURE PROGRAMMING

The Blanco County Family and Community Health Program Area Committee provides direction for FCH Outreach programming related to physical activity, safety, and general well-being. In 2023, the Walk AcrossTexas program will expand to include Blanco ISD. Additionally, the WAT! program will be held in the spring in partnership with Gem of the Hills Senior Activity Center.

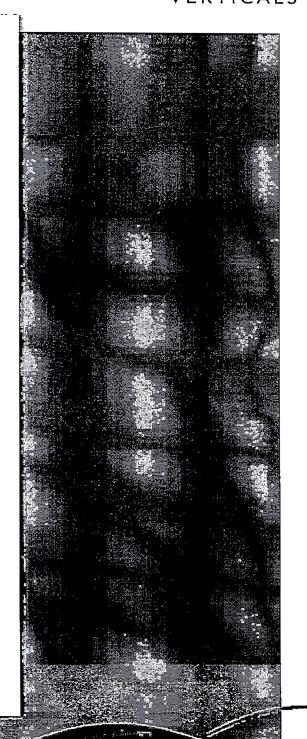

ELECTRONIC RECORDING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, dated ______, is between eRecording Partners Network, LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company, with a corporate office located at 6111 W. Plano Parkway, Suite 3800, Plano, Texas 75093 ("ePN") and Blanco County Clerk ("County") with an address of 101 E. Cypress Johnson City, TX 78636.

ePN offers a national electronic recording service to function as a trusted third party for title insurance companies, attorneys, mortgage bankers, full-service banks and other trusted entities to submit electronic documents to government entities for recording.

County desires to offer recording of real property documents by electronic transmission in substitution for conventional paper-based documents ("Electronic Recording") and to assure that transactions are not legally invalid or unenforceable as a result of the use of available electronic technologies for the mutual benefit of the parties of the transactions.

Program Eligibility

Title insurance companies, attorneys, mergage bankers, full-service banks and other trusted entities may directly or through a trusted third-party provider submit real property records for electronic recording. Electronic recordation pursuant to state law mandates a close working relationship as well as mutual trust between the County and the submitting entity. All parties to the Electronic Recording transaction desire to operate and maintain a secure recording system which provides some safeguards for interested parties to the Electronic Recording from deceit, fraud and forgery. This Memorandum of Understanding outlines the procedures and rules for the trusted relationship between ePN and the County to facilitate a safe and secure Electronic Recording relationship.

Participation in the Electronic Recording program is voluntary and the decision to do so is a business judgment.

There will be no added fees or costs of any kind charged by the County for Electronic Recording to ePN or any of its licensees.

County Requirements

The Electronic Recording Program of the County is defined by the requirements attached to this Memorandum of Understanding.

- ➤ Attachment A contains the County address and contact information.
- Attachment B contains the document and indexing specifications for the Electronic Recording program. For each document, the County specific document code is provided along with the required indexing information. Any County specific editing rules will also be described in this attachment. ePN acknowledges that County will reject and return any transactions that do not meet the document and indexing specifications.
- ➤ Attachment C contains the processing schedules and hours of operation for the Electronic Recording Program. Neither party shall be liable for any failure to perform processing of the transactions and documents where such failure results from any act of God or other cause beyond the party's reasonable control (including, without limitation, any mechanical, electronic or communications failure which prevents the parties from transmitting or receiving the Electronic Recording transactions. If the County system causes delays or power failures that interfere with the normal course of business, the County will notify ePN with a choice of using a courier service or waiting until the problem has been remedied.
- ➤ Attachment D provides the payment instructions for the Electronic Recording program. This form provides the account information for ePN to deposit payments via ACH into the County bank account.

ePN Responsibilities

ePN acknowledges that Electronic Recording permits it and/or its licensees to prepare, sign and/or transmit in electronic formats documents and business records. The document or record shall be considered as the "original" record of the transaction in substitution for, and with the same intended effect as, paper documents. Where the document or record bears a digital or electronic signature, said document or record shall be given the same presumption of validity as paper documents bearing handwritten signatures.

By use of electronic or digital certificates to sign documents, ePN and/or its licensees intend to be bound to those documents for all purposes as fully as if paper versions of the documents had been manually signed.

By use of electronic or digital certificates to sign documents, ePN and/or its licensees intend to be bound by those electronic signatures affixed to any documents and such electronic signature shall have the same legal effect as if that signature was manually affixed to a paper version of the document.

General Terms

The County will not incur any liability for the information electronically transmitted by ePN and/or its licensees. Should a dispute or legal action arise concerning an electronic transaction, the County will be held harmless and not liable for any damages which may be awarded against ePN. ePN



does not agree to indemnify County for actions or inactions of the County, including any damages awarded against the County for its own acts or omissions. Further, ePN does not agree to provide legal representation for the County for any actions brought against the County related to any Electronic Recording.

The County will not incur any liability for any breach of security, fraud or deceit as a result of Electronic Recording. Neither ePN nor the County shall be liable to the other for any special, incidental, exemplary or consequential damages arising from or as a result of any delay, omission or error in the Electronic Recording transmission or receipt.

ePN and the County will attempt in good faith to resolve any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to Electronic Recording through either negotiation or mediation prior to initiating litigation.

The County recognizes in many Electronic Recording transactions, ePN's licensees will be utilizing ePN's electronic recording solution and ePN will not be the actual entity recording the document or record. In the case of a dispute related to the authenticity of a document or record presented in an Electronic Recording transaction by one of ePN's licensees, the County agrees to not suspend or disable all of ePN's access to the Electronic Recording Program, but, rather, agrees to notify ePN of the issue so the access of the licensee may be suspended or disabled as required by the County. ePN will not be liable for defective documents or records recorded by its licensees while utilizing the Electronic Recording Program.

Either party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding for any reason by providing thirty (30) days written notice of termination.

Whereas, the Round Mountain VFD ("Accessing Agency") has requested, and Customer has agreed that the Accessing Agency be permitted, to access and use the Customer Agreement and Customer's Accessed System in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Access Agreement.

Now therefore, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. Customer and CentralSquare grant Accessing Agency permission to allow access and use of the Customer Agreement terms and Accessed System under the terms of this Access Agreement. Customer grants Accessing Agency the right to utilize the Customer System ("Accessed System") in order to exchange public safety data (which includes but is not limited to CAD, RMS and other law enforcement agency data) between Customer and Accessing Agency, subject to the terms herein.
- 2. CentralSquare and Customer each have the right to terminate this Access Agreement, and accordingly, Accessing Agency's access to the Accessed System and Customer Agreement at CentralSquare's or Customer's discretion.

Any such license can only be affected by the execution by Accessing Agency and CentralSquare of a definitive written software license agreement between CentralSquare and Accessing Agency that, by its express terms, purports to provide such a right of license to Accessing Agency. CentralSquare will have no obligations whatsoever to Accessing Agency in connection with the Software. AS BETWEEN CENTRALSQUARE AND ACCESSING AGENCY, THE SOFTWARE IS MADE AVAILABLE ON AN "AS IS" BASIS. CENTRALSQUARE MAKES NO WARRANTIES WHATSOEVER TO ACCESSING AGENCY REGARDING THE SOFTWARE, AND HEREBY DISCLAIMS ANY AND ALL WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WITHOUT LIMITATION ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, NON-INFRINGEMENT AND/OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. CENTRALSQUARE WILL HAVE NO LIABILITY TO OR THROUGH ACCESSING AGENCY UNDER OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS ACCESS AGREEMENT OR OTHERWISE IN CONNECTION WITH THE SOFTWARE, IN WHOLE OR IN PART.
- 6. Customer grants Accessing Agency use of the Customer Agreement as-is, allowing Accessing Agency to purchase additional licenses, services, and support for Accessing Agency's sole use via a quote or sales order subject to the terms and conditions of the Customer Agreement.
- 7. Subject to compliance with applicable laws, Customer and Accessing Agency may agree to share and contribute data directly or indirectly into the Accessed System for the use in implementation and performance of the Accessed System. Each party shall be the respective owner of their own data and no ownership rights shall transfer by the use or contribution of said data.
- 8. Customer and Accessing Agency agree to be bound by the most current version of the FBI CJIS Security Policy and are responsible for maintaining the required certifications for access to the respective state's CJIS system(s), NCIC, and/or other local state, federal, and/or other applicable systems.
- 9. Accessing Agency shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless CentralSquare, and their respective officers, directors, employees, agents, successors, and assigns from and against any and all losses incurred by either CentralSquare resulting from any action by a third party that arise out of or result from, or are alleged to arise out of or result from the gross negligence or more culpable act or omission (including recklessness or willful misconduct) by Accessing Agency, any authorized user, or any third party on behalf of Accessing Agency or any authorized user, in connection with this Access Agreement.
- 10. This Access Agreement will be governed by and construed under the laws of the State of Texas, without reference to the choice of laws provisions thereof. If any provision of this Agreement is illegal or unenforceable, it will be deemed stricken from this Access Agreement and the remaining provisions of this Access Agreement will remain in full force and effect.
- 11. Customer shall be the first point of contact for the Accessing Agency for Accessed Software in the event that support services are required by the Accessing Agency. Should Customer not be able to solve the Support Service issue, Customer shall contact or coordinate contact with CentralSquare for support services.

12. This Access Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties with respect to its subject matter and supersedes and extinguishes all prior oral and written communications between the parties about its subject matter. No modification of this Access Agreement will be effective unless it is in writing, is signed by each party, and expressly provides that it amends this Access Agreement.

By the signatures of their duly authorized representatives below, CentralSquare, Customer, and Accessing Agency, intending to be legally bound, agree to all of the provisions of this Access Agreement.
