

WHEREAS, each business, school, government agency, health care provider, organization, and citizen shares the burden of mental health challenges and has a responsibility to promote mental wellness and support prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Blanco County Commissioners Court wishes to enhance public awareness of mental health and diminish the associated stigma;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it proclaimed that the Blanco County Commissioners Court, acting in its capacity as the governing body of Blanco County, hereby recognizes May 2025 as Mental Health Awareness Month in Blanco County and calls upon the community to increase awareness and understanding of mental illnesses, reduce stigma and discrimination, and promote appropriate and accessible services for all people with mental health conditions.

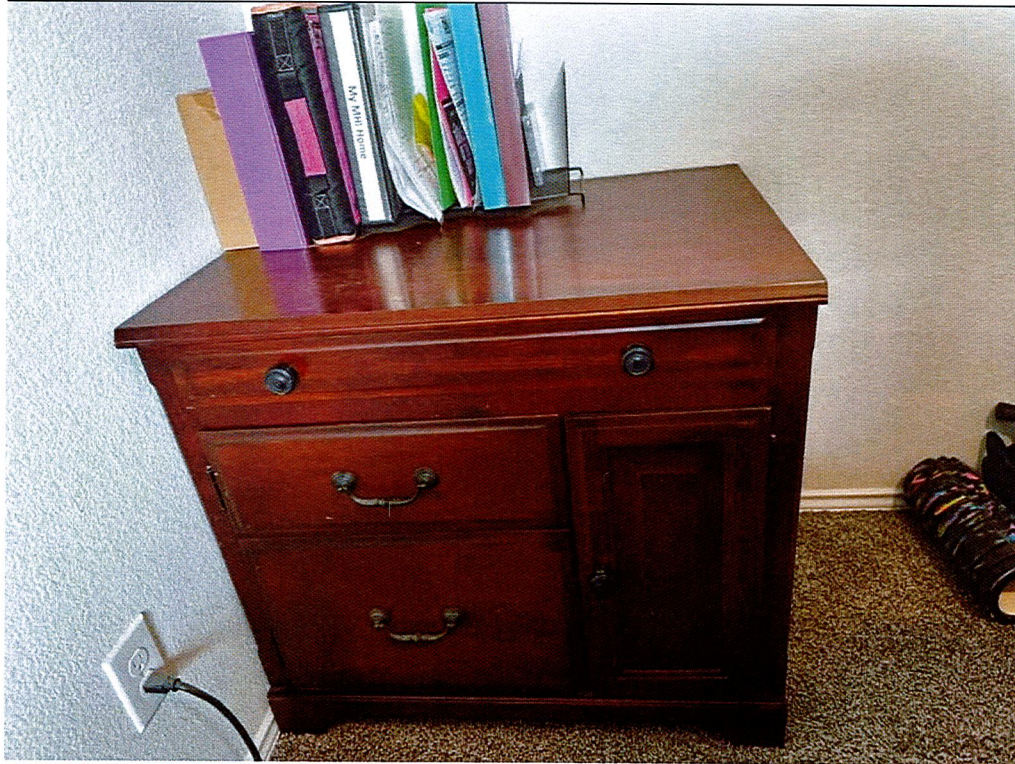



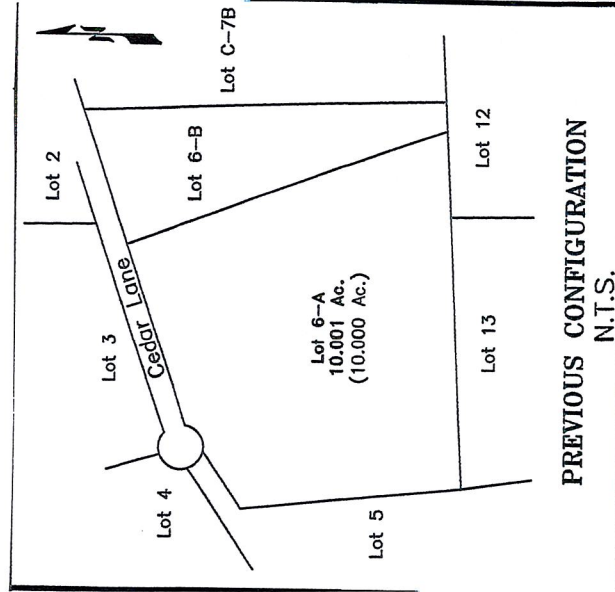
