

The Blanco County Office Annex is located on the town square in Johnson City, Texas, It was conceived as (2) buildings separated by a Public Courtyard. The Courtyard gives deference to the historic courthouse directly across the street, contains native plantings, and provides a breezy area for recesses outside the Courtroom Building and Office Building. The courtyard is surrounded by a covered walkway canopy constructed of galvanized steel and cedar decking. Both buildings are sited off the street corners to preserve rows of trees along both sides of the property. The 6400 sf Office Building houses the County Clerk, Tax Office and Agriculture Service. The 4800sf Meeting/Courtroom Building sits opposite the Office Building. The Public Meeting Room and Courtroom are separated by a movable partition to provide flexibility. Limestone, metal roofing, and wood windows are utilized and detailed to relate the new buildings to the historic courthouse






This new Athletic Complex will be utilized as a gymnasium and will also function as a FEMA-compliant safe shelter with capacity for 705 occupants. The team worked in concert with Bloomington's officials on the design, engineering and now construction of the dome, which is being built through the Texas Safe Shelter Initiative under the direction of the Texas Department of Emergency Management, funded through the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. Innovative features of the 20,000 square foot project include its low profile roofline.

Most communities have iconic school buildings which are either difficult to maintain or have fallen into severe disrepair. Planning for these structures is rarely pragmatic & is usually governed by a broad range of emotional responses. The hometown grandmother has a vastly different viewpoint than the new urban commuter. Negotiating this divide is a challenge but can create a rich common vision, as is evident in this project.

We began with a "subjective analysis" to determine the prioritized perceived needs of the district. Separate workshops were held with site based committee, district admin & school board. The results were reviewed & developed further with a broad based citizen committee. It quickly became evident that the 1885 schoolhouse was THE master plan keystone. By preserving the 1885 facade & walls as part of a state of the art educational environment, the district had a win-win solution that bridged divergent segments in the community & became xxxa positive focus for the project.

This project meets the challenge of integrating new building materials & systems with building components preserved after 130 years of use. New & old fit seamlessly, but with subtle distinction of each. Split-face CMU, limestone veneer & historic limestone blocks are in a complementary arrangement. The library, located in what has been an assembly space since 1885, will be used as a community gathering space. A renovated vestibule provides a secure public entry for the campus.

A gallery hall with rotating exhibits is located at the main entry to offer students a walk-thru history lesson built around found artifacts & photos of their school building's evolution over the past 130 years. Classroom wings flank common use areas for upper grades in the new building, while the cafeteria is relocated to a more campus -central location. By replacing all construction within the historic stone walls, all building systems & technology are fully integrated into the architecture.



This project was conceived as more than just a high school, but the center of community life. A very strong arts group uses the PAC for multiple performances during the year. The athletic complex is the heart of community activities. The secondary gym is available for use after hours by all. The campus design has preserved the natural hill country landscape & employs a pallet of materials that speaks to that setting.

The building material pallet reflects both the landscape & the Texas hill country architectural style. This is expressed through the use of limestone building veneer, expanses of glazing that bring the outdoors in, & exposed building structure that is reminiscent of area agricultural buildings. Separating the PAC, fieldhouse & auxiliary gym help to reduce the scale of the building mass. The stadium's concession plaza overlooks the football field & the panoramic view of the lakefront beyond.

This is truly a 21st century schoolhouse. What was originally preconceived as a high school library ended up a student center after the decision was made to have no books. Through an agreement with the local library, students have access to 10x more volumes on-line than are housed in a traditional school library. Each student is issued a tablet computer, each classroom is outfitted with smart boards, & the entire campus (even the stadium) is networked wirelessly. No textbooks, no library, no lockers... but lots of learning!



Foremost this school is designed to house students from 7th to 12th grade, with optimum use of common amenities, but maintaining the separation required for these different age groups. Interior glazing allows views in (to display learning) & out (to allow natural surveillance). Masonry is used extensively, interior & exterior, for areas accessible to student traffic wear. A soaring main commons area connects upper & lower grade entries, & serves as a lobby for library, office & computer labs.

This project was completed in 2013 with a building construction cost of \$140.55/SF, with no sacrifice in quality or features. This economy was accomplished using many innovative design strategies, including: using simple but dynamic building geometries, an efficient floor plan & optimizing building finishes. Rolling grilles allow public use of the library & technology center without compromising security. Future expandability is accommodated in the design to fit the district's master plan.












