

ADDENDUM #2 TO REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL #2

VOTE TABULATION SYSTEM FOR CALDWELL COUNTY

1. Omit the following sections: 3.01.02, 3.02.01 and 3.13.26
2. Amendment to following Sections:
 - 3.01.06 Bidder must be certified by the Texas Secretary of State for the system being bid on.
 - 3.11.04 Ability to support at 500 ballot styles on a single voting unit.
 - 3.11.05 Ability to support at least 50 splits in a precinct.
 - 3.11.12 Ability of the election management system, precinct tabulator and vote marking device to support at least 5 (five) languages, including character-based languages like Chinese.
 - 3.12.02 Support 11"-,14"-, 17" and 19"-length ballot pages. 3.12.03 Support 4.25"-and 8.5"-wide ballot pages and to include double sided ballot.
 - 3.12.09 Use style sheets during ballot design to format the appearance of multiple contests with a single action as prescribed by Texas Election Code.
 - 3.12.24 Enable up to 10 users to connect to the election management database simultaneously.
 - 3.13.23 Scan and store full, complete ballot images at the minimum of 300 dots per inch (DPI) or higher.
 - 3.13.35 Be the election vendor, purpose-built equipment; cannot be commercial-off-the-shelf (COTS) hardware.
 - 3.14.11 Include a touch screen of at least 15 inches to make voting selections.
 - 3.13.36 if allowed, provide for the secure transmission of results via landline or wireless modem from the precinct tabulator to the EMS as prescribed by Texas Election Code.
 - 3.14.32 Accept ballots/cards or 11inch, 14-inch, 17-inch and 19-inch lengths plus support 3.12.03 and double sided ballot.
