**Note:** This amendment corrects the current version of this subsection, which erroneously refers to the required performance period for public improvements as one year instead of two years. Section 2.0 of the ordinance defines the performance period as a two-year period during which a developer retains responsibility for maintenance. Section 3.8 and 3.8.2, and the rest of section 3.8.5 all correctly state the performance period as two years.
