**JOINT WORKSHOP** with the Lockhart City Council to obtain information, ask questions, and discuss issues related to EMS service in the City of Lockhart and Caldwell County, including receipt of any proposals by service providers under the 1115 Waiver Program. No Action will be taken.

Judge Bonn called the meeting to order. Commissioner Cyrier, Commissioner Buchholtz and Commissioner Roland were present at start of meeting. Mayor White and all City Council members were present. Members of the panel attending were Russell Weaver, CTMC, Sam Huenergardt, President & CEO CTMC, Mike Hendricks, Mayor of Luling, Glen Germer, Executive Director of EMS Luling, Neal Kelley, COO Seton Healthcare, and Aaron Langford, Director of EMS Lockhart. Commissioner Madrigal arrived at 7:15 p.m. Several questions from City Council Members, the Commissioners and the public citizens concerning changes that may occur with staff and procedures were answered. Neal Kelley assured the citizens that when service was requested that the patient would be taken to the hospital of choice if it was possible. Mike Hendricks assures those present that he has never had a complaint about the service provided in Luling. Glen Germer discusses the continuation of CCMAT and the possible ongoing programs available through Seton and would like to see it continue for the community. There will be a second workshop on September 19, 2012, at the County Courthouse.
