## OCCUPATIONAL DRIVERS LICENSE

Requirements from the Judge: (The following requirements are to be provided to the court before the case may be set for hearing, NO EXCEPTIONS.)

- \* Filing fee for Occupational Driver's License \$265.00;
- \* Petition for Occupational Driver's License (<u>must have effective</u> <u>beginning and ending dates, counties requesting to drive through and hours requesting to drive</u>)
- \* Waiver of Citation
- \* Original SR 22 (Provided by your Insurance Company) (this is a Pink Form)
- \* Letter from his/her Employer;
  - 1. Confirming Employment &
  - 2. Work Schedule
- \* If the applicant is on probation, then provide a letter from his/her current probation officer stating the status of his/her probation (letter must be no more than 30 days from date of filing letter until hearing) and a copy of the application shall be presented to the applicants probation officer on the day of filing of the application;
- \* The Notice of Suspension from the Texas Department of Public Safety;
- \* All Orders for Occupation/Restricted driver's license must <u>provide</u>

  <u>Effective Beginning and Ending Dates</u>, Counties requesting to drive

  <u>through and Hours requesting to drive</u>, the Order for the Occupational

  <u>Driver's License must be on file before scheduling a hearing</u>;
- \* The Court requires that if an attorney signs any pleading in the case, the attorney must appear at the hearing on the application for Occupation Driver's License;
- \* No Occupation Driver's License will be granted without the <u>Personal</u> <u>Appearance</u> of the named applicant at the hearing.
- \* After all requirements are met; a Motion to Set must be filed with the civil clerk, in order to be put on the next available docket. Check with the clerk for dates and time.
