NOTICE OF BOND ELECTION

TAKE NOTICE that an election will be held in the Plains Independent School District on May 4, 2024 concerning the issuance of bonds in accordance with an order that reads substantially as follows:

ORDER CALLING A BOND ELECTION FOR MAY 4, 2024

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Plains Independent School District (the "District") deems it advisable to call the bond election hereinafter ordered (the "Election"); and

WHEREAS, the Board hereby finds and determines that the anticipated capital improvements identified in Proposition B may be submitted to the qualified voters of the District as a single proposition pursuant to Section 45.003(g) of the Texas Education Code because these capital improvements will be predominantly used for educational and administrative purposes, none of which are the type of facilities described in Section 45.003(g)(1) - (6), Texas Education Code; and

WHEREAS, it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this Order was adopted was open to the public, and public notice of the time, place, and purpose of the meeting was given, all as required by the Texas Government Code, Chapter 551.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE PLAINS INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT:

- **Section 1. Findings**. The statements contained in the preamble of this Order are true and correct and adopted as findings of fact and operative provisions hereof.
- **Section 2. Election Ordered; Polling Places**. The Election shall be held in the District between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on May 4, 2024 ("Election Day"). The Election is to be conducted by the District at the locations designated by the District as identified on <u>Exhibit B</u> to this Order. As permitted by the Code, polling places may be changed without further Board action; any changes will not affect this Order or subsequent notice of election.
- **Section 3. Early Voting**. Early voting shall be administered by the District. Early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance at the dates, times, and places shown on Exhibit B.
- **Section 4. Election Officials**. The appointment of the Presiding Election Judge, Alternate Judges, Early Voting Clerks, the Presiding Judge of the early ballot board and other election officials for the Election shall be made by the District in accordance with the Code. The District may employ other personnel necessary for the proper administration of the Election, including such part-time help as is necessary to prepare for the Election, to ensure the timely delivery of supplies during early voting and on Election Day, and for the efficient tabulation of ballots at the central counting station.
- **Section 5.** Voting by Mail. Applications for voting by mail for all residents of the District shall be received not later than April 23, 2024. Applications should be sent to: Jessica Williamson, Early Voting

Section 6. Early Voting Ballots. An Early Voting Ballot Board shall be created to process early voting results of the Election and the Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board shall be designated by the District. The Presiding Judge of the Early Voting Ballot Board shall appoint two or more additional members to constitute the Early Voting Ballot Board members and, if needed, the Signature Verification Committee members required to efficiently process the early voting ballots.

Section 7. Qualified Voters. All qualified electors of and residing in the District shall be entitled to vote at the election.

Section 8. Propositions. At the Election the following PROPOSITIONS shall be submitted in accordance with law:

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Plains Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$15,495,628 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, renovating and equipping school facilities, the purchase of necessary sites for school facilities, and the purchase of school buses and vehicles, with the bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds?

Shall the Board of Trustees of the Plains Independent School District be authorized to issue the bonds of the District, in one or more series, in the aggregate principal amount of \$29,284,372 for the purpose of constructing, acquiring, and equipping recreational facilities in the District, including a new field house, weight room, track, tennis courts, concession stand, bleachers and indoor practice facility, with any surplus proceeds remaining after completion of such projects to be used for the construction, acquisition, renovation and equipment of other recreational facilities in the District, with the bonds to mature, bear interest, and be issued and sold in accordance with law at the time of issuance; and shall the Board of Trustees be authorized to levy and pledge, and cause to be assessed and collected, annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds?

Section 9. Ballots. The official ballots for the Election shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code so as to permit the electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid PROPOSITIONS with the ballots to contain such provisions, markings and language as required by law, and with such PROPOSITIONS to be expressed substantially as follows:

Section 10. Compliance with Federal Law. In all respects, the Election shall be conducted in accordance with the Code. Pursuant to the federal Help America Vote Act ("HAVA") and the Code, at each polling place there shall be at least one voting system that is equipped for disabled individuals, and each such voting system shall be a system that has been certified by the Texas Secretary of State as compliant with HAVA and the Code. The District hereby finds that the voting systems to be used by the District in administering the Election is such a system, and orders that such voting equipment or other equipment certified by the Texas Secretary of State shall be used by the District in its elections.

- **Section 11. Debt Obligations**. The following information is provided in accordance with the provisions of Section 3.009(b), Texas Election Code.
 - (a) The proposition language that will appear on the ballot is set forth in Section 9 hereof.
 - (b) The purpose for which the bonds are to be authorized is set forth in Section 8 hereof.
 - (c) The principal amount of the debt obligations to be authorized is \$15,495,628 for Proposition A and \$29,284,372 for Proposition B.
 - (d) If the bonds are approved by the voters, the Board of Trustees will be authorized to levy annual ad valorem taxes, on all taxable property in the District, sufficient, without limit as to rate or amount, to pay the principal of and interest on the bonds and the cost of any credit agreements executed in connection with the bonds.
 - (e) Based upon the bond market conditions at the date of adoption of this Order, the maximum interest rate for any series of the bonds is estimated to be 4.50%. Such estimate takes into account a number of factors, including the issuance schedule, maturity schedule and the expected bond ratings of the proposed bonds and notes. Such estimated maximum interest rate is provided as a matter of information, but is not a limitation on the interest rate at which the bonds or notes, or any series thereof, may be sold.
 - (f) If the bonds are approved, they may be issued in one or more series, to mature serially, over a period not to exceed 15 years from the date of issuance of each series of bonds.
 - (g) The aggregate amount of the outstanding principal of the District's debt obligations as of the date of this Order is \$9,460,000.00.
 - (h) The aggregate amount of the outstanding interest of the District's debt obligations as of the date of this Order is \$847,725.00.

- (i) The ad valorem debt service tax rate for the District as of the date of this Order is \$0.2825 per \$100 of taxable assessed valuation.
- **Section 12. Voter Information Documents**. The voter information documents required by Section 1251.052(b), Texas Government Code, shall be in the form attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u>.
