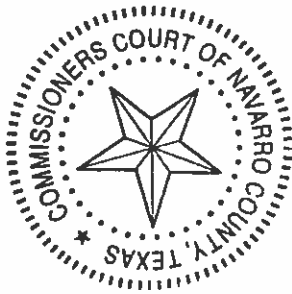



To the Board of Commissioners
Navarro County Emergency Services District #1

Report on the Financial Statements

I have audited the accompanying financial statements of the governmental activities of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1, as of and for the year ended September 30, 2018, and the related notes to the financial statements, which collectively comprise the District's basic financial statements as listed in the table of contents.

Management's Responsibility for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America; this includes the design, implementation, and maintenance of internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditor's Responsibility

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit. I conducted my audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that I plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.

An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal control relevant to the entity's preparation and fair presentation of the financial statements in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the entity's internal control. Accordingly, I express no such opinion. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of significant accounting estimates made by management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.

I believe that the audit evidence I have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for my audit opinion.

Opinion

In my opinion, the financial statements referred to above present fairly, in all material respects, the respective financial position of the governmental activities of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1, as of September 30, 2018, and the respective changes in financial position for the year then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

Other Matters

Required Supplementary Information

Accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America require that the management's discussion and analysis on pages ii-iv be presented to supplement the basic financial statements. Such information, although not a part of the basic financial statements, is required by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board, who considers it to be an essential part of financial reporting for placing the basic financial statements in an appropriate operational, economic, or historical context. I have applied certain limited procedures to the required supplementary information in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America, which consisted of inquiries of management about the methods of preparing the information and comparing the information for consistency with management's responses to my inquiries, the basic financial statements, and other knowledge I obtained during my audit of the basic financial statements. I do not express an opinion or provide any assurance on the information because the limited procedures do not provide me with sufficient evidence to express an opinion or provide any assurance.

Management's Discussion and Analysis

Navarro County Emergency Services District #1

As management of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1, we offer readers of the District's financial statements this narrative overview and analysis of the financial activities of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 for the fiscal year ended September 30, 2018. The District was created as a result of an election held November 6, 2007. The first meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held January 6, 2008.

Financial Highlights

- The assets of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 exceeded its liabilities at the close of the most recent fiscal period by \$ 297,772.66 (net position). Of this amount, \$ 102,463.72 may be used to meet the District's ongoing obligations to citizens and creditors.
- The District's total net position during the year increased by \$ 18,255.53.
- At the close of the current fiscal period, the District had no debt outstanding.

Overview of the Financial Statements

This discussion and analysis are intended to service as an introduction to the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1's basic financial statements. The District's basic financial statements comprise three components: (1) government-wide financial statements, (2) fund financial statements, and (3) notes to the financial statements.

Government-wide financial statements. The *government-wide financial statements* are designed to provide readers with a broad overview of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1's finances, in a manner similar to a private-sector business.

The *statement of net position* presents information on all of the District's assets and liabilities, with the difference between the two reported as *net position*. Over time, increases or decreases in net position may serve as a useful indicator of whether the financial position of the District is improving or deteriorating.

The *statement of activities* presents information showing how the government's net position changed during the most recent fiscal period. All changes in net position are reported as soon as the underlying event giving rise to the change occurs, *regardless of the timing of related cash flows*.

The governmental activities of the District reported in the government-wide financial statements include general government activities. The government-wide financial statements can be found on pages 1 and 2 of this report.

Fund Financial Statements. A fund is a grouping of related accounts that is used to maintain control over resources that have been segregated for specific activities or objectives. The Navarro County Emergency Services District #1, like other state and local governments, uses fund accounting to ensure and demonstrate compliance with finance-related legal requirements. The Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 has only a General Fund, which is a governmental fund.

Governmental funds: *Governmental funds* are used to account for essentially the same functions reported as *governmental activities* in the government-wide financial statements. However, unlike the government-wide financial statements, governmental fund financial statements focus on *near-term inflows and outflows of spendable resources*, as well as on *balances of spendable resource* available at the end of the fiscal year. Such information may be useful in evaluating a government's near-term financial requirements.

Because the focus of governmental funds is narrower than that of the government-wide financial statements, it is useful to compare the information presented for *governmental funds* with similar information presented for *governmental activities* in the government-wide financial statements. By doing so, readers may better understand the long-term impact of the government's near-term financing decisions. Both the governmental fund balance sheet and the governmental fund statement of revenues, expenditures, and changes in fund balances provide a reconciliation to facilitate this comparison between *governmental funds* and *governmental activities*. The basic governmental fund financial statements can be found on pages 3 and 4 of this report.

The Navarro Emergency Services District #1 maintains one governmental fund, the General Fund. It is not required by state statutes to adopt a budget. However, the District annually prepares and approves a budget that is used as a management tool.

Notes to the financial statements. The notes provide additional information that is essential to a full understanding of the data provided in the government-wide and fund financial statements. The notes to the financial statements can be found on pages 6-8 of this report.

Overview of the District's Financial Position and Operations

As noted earlier, net position may serve over time as a useful indicator of a government's financial position. In the case of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1, assets exceeded liabilities by \$ 297,772.66 at the close of the most recent fiscal year. The District's overall financial position and operations for the past two years is summarized as follows based on the information included in the government-wide financial statements.

I. Reporting Entity and Financial Reporting

The Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 is a political subdivision of the State of Texas, created as a result of a public election held November 6, 2007, under the provisions of Section 48-e of Article III of the Constitution of the State of Texas and Chapter 775 of the Texas Health and Safety Code. The Board of Commissioners held its first meeting on January 6, 2008. An Emergency Services District may support or provide local emergency services, including emergency medical services, emergency ambulance services, rural fire prevention and control services, and other emergency services authorized by the Texas Legislature. The purpose of the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 is to provide fire prevention and control services for the geographic area included in the Kerens Independent School District. The accompanying financial statements are those of the District, the only entity for which the District is financially accountable.

II. Summary of significant accounting policies

(A) Government-wide and fund financial statements

The government-wide financial statements (i.e. the statement of net position, and the statement of activities) report information on all of the nonfiduciary activities of the primary government. *Governmental activities*, which normally are supported by taxes and intergovernmental revenues, are reported separately from *business-type activities*, which rely to a significant extent on fees and charges for support.

The statement of activities demonstrates the degree to which the direct expenses of a given function or segment is offset by program revenues. *Direct expenses* are those that are clearly identifiable with a specific function or segment. *Program revenues* include 1) charges to customers or applicants who purchase, use, or directly benefit from goods, services, or privileges provided by a given function or segment and 2) grants and contributions that are restricted to meeting the operational or capital requirements of a particular function or segment. Taxes and other items not properly included among program revenues are reported instead as *general revenues*.

Separate financial statements are provided for governmental funds. Major individual governmental funds are reported as separate columns in the fund financial statements.

(B) Measurement focus, basis of accounting and financial statement presentation

The government-wide financial statements are reported using the *economic resources measurement focus* and the *accrual basis of accounting*. Revenues are recorded when earned and expenses are recorded when a liability is incurred, regardless of the timing of related cash flows. Property taxes are recognized as revenues in the year for which they are levied. Grants and similar items are recognized as revenue as soon as all eligibility requirements imposed by the provider have been met.

Governmental fund financial statements are reported using the *current financial resources measurement focus* and the *modified accrual basis of accounting*. Revenues are recognized as soon as they are both measurable and available. Revenues are considered to be *available* when they are collectible within the current period or soon enough thereafter to pay liabilities of the current period. For this purpose, the District considers revenues to be available if they are collected within 60 days of the end of the current fiscal period. Expenditures generally are recorded when a liability is incurred as under accrual accounting.

The District reports the following major governmental funds:

General Fund - The general fund is the District's primary operating fund. It is used to account for all financial resources of the general government except those required to be accounted for in another fund.

(C) Assets, liabilities, and net position or equity

(1) Deposits

The District's cash and cash equivalents consist of three demand deposit accounts, one of which is an interest-bearing savings account. The District has a demand deposit account for the purpose of segregating funds received from Navarro County to be used for supplementing fuel costs for fire-fighting equipment.

When both restricted and unrestricted resources are available for use, it is the District's policy to use restricted resources first, then unrestricted resources as they are needed.

(2) Receivables

All receivables are shown net of estimated uncollectible amounts.

(3) Property Taxes

The appraisal of property within the District is the responsibility of the Navarro County Appraisal District. The Emergency Service District's property tax is levied each October 1 on the assessed value listed as of the prior January 1 for all real and business personal property located in the District. The net assessed value upon which the fiscal 2017 levy was based was \$ 295,948,999. Taxes are due by the January 31 following the October 1 levy date. Current tax collections for the year ended September 30, 2018 were 96.08% of the tax levy.

(III) Reconciliation of Government-Wide and Fund Financial Statements

The governmental fund balance sheet includes a reconciliation between fund balance of total governmental funds and net position of governmental activities as reported in the government-wide statement of net position.

The governmental statement of revenues, expenditures, and changes in fund balances includes a reconciliation between net changes in fund balances of total governmental funds and changes in net position of governmental activities as reported in the government-wide statement of activities.

(IV) Stewardship, compliance, and accountability

State statutes do not require that an emergency services district adopt a budget; however, the Navarro County Emergency Services District #1 Board of Commissioners annually prepares and approves a budget to use as a financial management tool.

(V) Detailed Notes on All Funds

A. Deposits

As of September 30, 2018, the District's carrying amount of deposits was \$ 86,316.59; the bank balance was \$87,990.39. All bank balances were entirely covered by federal depository insurance coverage.

B. Receivables

As of year-end, receivables consisted of property taxes receivable in the amount of \$ 19,463.83.

C. Note Payable

On December 16, 2015 the District obtained a short-term note payable from the Powell State Bank in the amount of \$149,683.05, for the purchase of a 2015 Ford F550 Brush Truck. During the fiscal year ended September 30, 2018 the entire short-term note payable was retired.

D. Fire Protection Services

The District has agreements with two local volunteer fire departments, Kerens VFD and 287 R/C Fire and Rescue, to provide fire protection and prevention services to the residents of the District. The District also maintains the Emergency Services Fire Department, which is staffed by volunteers. The District receives a monthly subsidy from Navarro County for the purpose of fueling and maintaining the fire fighting vehicles owned by the District.

F. Deferred Inflows of Resources

In addition to liabilities, the statement of financial position will sometimes report a separate section for deferred inflow of resources. This separate financial statement element, *deferred inflows of resources*, represents an acquisition of net position that applies to a future period and so will *not* be recognized as an inflow of resources (revenue) until that time. The district has only one type of item, which arises only under a modified accrual basis of accounting, that qualifies for reporting in this category. Accordingly, the item, *unavailable revenue*, is reported only in the governmental funds balance sheet. The governmental funds report unavailable revenue from property taxes. This amount is deferred and recognized as an inflow of resources in the period that the amount becomes available.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-11

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO, TEXAS, APPROVING THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO, TEXAS AND SLAMN JMMBN OPPORTUNISTS LLC FOR A PROPERTY TAX ABATEMENT IN THE CORSICANA DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION DISTRICT, AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION BY THE COUNTY JUDGE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, upon full review and consideration of the AGREEMENT, and all matters attendant and related thereto, the Commissioners Court is of the opinion that the terms and conditions thereof should be approved, and that the County Judge shall be authorized to execute it on behalf of the County of Navarro.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO, TEXAS:

Section 1. The terms and conditions of the proposed AGREEMENT, having been reviewed by the Commissioners Court of the County of Navarro, Texas and found to be acceptable and in the best interests of the County of Navarro and its citizens, are hereby in all things approved.

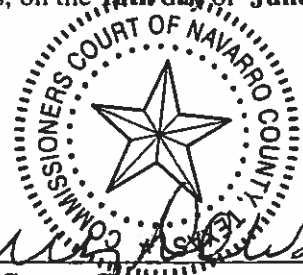

TAX ABATEMENT AGREEMENT

This Tax Abatement Agreement (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between THE COUNTY OF NAVARRO, a political subdivision of the State of Texas, acting herein by and through its County Judge and hereinafter referred to as COUNTY, and SLAMN JMMBN OPPORTUNISTS LLC, a Texas limited liability corporation, hereinafter referred to as OWNER.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, on the 11th day of February, 2019, the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, herein after the CITY, passed an Ordinance creating and designating the Corsicana Downtown Revitalization District (the "Reinvestment Zone") for commercial tax abatement, as authorized by Chapter 312, Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has previously adopted a Tax Abatement Policy (the "Tax Abatement Policy") and a Historic Downtown Tax Abatement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Downtown Tax Abatement Program constitutes appropriate guidelines and criteria governing tax abatement agreements to be entered into by COUNTY as required by Chapter 312, Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has adopted a resolution stating that it elects to be eligible to participate in tax abatement; and

WHEREAS, CITY has sent written notice that CITY intends to enter into this AGREEMENT, including a copy of this AGREEMENT, to the presiding officer of the governing body of each other taxing unit in which property to be subject to this AGREEMENT is located, as required by Section 312.2041 of the Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, in order to maintain and/or enhance the commercial economic and employment base of the City of Corsicana area to the long term interest and benefit of the COUNTY, the COUNTY has determined that the contemplated use of the PROPERTY, as hereinafter defined, the contemplated improvements to the PROPERTY in the amount as set forth in this AGREEMENT, and the other terms hereof are consistent with encouraging development of said Reinvestment Zone in accordance with the purposes for its creation and are in compliance with COUNTY'S Historic Downtown Tax Abatement Program;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual benefits and promises contained herein and for good and other valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto do mutually agree as follows:

I.
DEFINITIONS

Whenever used in this Agreement, the following terms shall have the meanings ascribed to them:

1.1 “Estimated Tax Value” means the estimated depreciated Tax Net Book Values applicable to the real property improvements and the Tangible Personal Property improvements comprising the Investment described in Paragraph 2.2 below. For reference purposes, the Estimated Tax Values scheduled on are determined using the Navarro Central Appraisal District’s appraisal guidelines in effect as of the date of this Agreement.

1.2 “Event of Bankruptcy or Insolvency” means the dissolution or termination of a party’s existence as a going business, insolvency, appointment of receiver for any part of a party’s property and such appointment is not terminated within ninety (90) days after such appointment is initially made, any general assignment for the benefit of creditors, or the commencement of any proceeding under any bankruptcy or insolvency laws by or against such party and such proceeding is not dismissed within ninety (90) days after the filing thereof.

1.3 “Force Majeure” means any contingency or cause beyond the reasonable control of OWNER including, without limitation, acts of God or the public enemy, war, riot; civil commotion, insurrection, adverse weather, governmental or de facto governmental action (unless caused by acts or omissions of OWNER), fires; explosions or floods, and strikes.

1.4 “In Service Project Cost” means the initial project cost of the Improvements identified and defined below, as of the date such Improvements are first placed into service by OWNER.

1.5 “Tangible Personal Property” means tangible personal property classified as such under state law and hereafter located on the Property, but expressly excludes inventory and supplies, and any tangible personal property that was located in the Reinvestment Zone at any time before the date of this Agreement.

1.6 “Taxable Value” means the appraised value as certified by the Navarro County Appraisal District as of January 1 of a given year.

Other terms defined elsewhere in this Agreement shall have the meanings therein ascribed to those terms.

II.
OWNER’S OBLIGATIONS

2.1 The specific property to be the subject of this Agreement shall be the Real Property, including land and improvements, located at 220 North Beaton Street in Corsicana, described as Block 251, Lot 10, Property ID No. 40088, and by map attached hereto as EXHIBIT A and made a part hereof, and shall be herein referred to as the PROPERTY.

2.2 For the purposes of fulfilling this Agreement, the OWNER shall make improvements to the real property as described in Exhibit "C" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (collectively the "Improvements"), having a total In Service Project Cost of at least \$258,000.00. On or before December 31, 2018, OWNER shall substantially complete all Improvements. Notwithstanding the foregoing deadline, OWNER shall have such additional time to satisfy the obligations contained in this Paragraph 2.2 as may reasonably be required in the event of Force Majeure if OWNER is diligently and faithfully pursuing satisfaction of the applicable obligation. The date of substantial completion of the Improvements shall be defined as the date a Certificate of Occupancy is issued by the CITY.

2.3 As good and valuable consideration for this Agreement, OWNER agrees and covenants that it will diligently and faithfully pursue the completion of the Improvements in a good and workmanlike manner. OWNER further covenants and agrees that all construction of the Improvements and use of the Property will be in accordance with all applicable State and local laws, codes, and regulations (or valid waiver thereof).

2.4 OWNER further agrees that the COUNTY, its agents and employees shall have reasonable right of access to the Property, upon not less than ten (10) days prior written notice, to inspect the Improvements in order to ensure that the construction of the Improvements is in accordance with this Agreement and all applicable State and local laws and regulations (or valid waiver thereof). After completion of the Improvements, the COUNTY shall have the continuing right to inspect the Property, upon not less than ten (10) days prior written notice, to ensure that it is thereafter maintained in accordance with this Agreement throughout the Term of this Agreement. In addition, the OWNER agrees that appraisal district representatives shall have reasonable right of access to the Property, upon not less than ten (10) days prior written notice, for the purpose of ad valorem property tax appraisal for all real property and improvements to real property.

**III.
ABATEMENT OF TAXES**

3.1 Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, and subject to the rights of holders of any outstanding bonds of the COUNTY, a portion of ad valorem real property taxes from the Property that are otherwise owed to the COUNTY, shall be frozen at the appraised value of the Property on December 31, 2018. Said ad valorem real property tax abatement/freeze shall be for a five (5) year term, beginning in tax year 2019, and shall apply to the taxes assessed upon the increased value of the eligible Property, after installation of the real property improvements contemplated by Paragraph 2.2, over the value of the Property in the year in which this Agreement is executed; all subject to and in accordance with the terms of this Agreement, the Tax Abatement Policy, Chapter 312, Texas Tax Code, and all applicable state and local regulations (or valid waiver thereat).

3.2 It is understood and agreed among the parties that the Property shall be appraised at market value for the purposes of the applicable real property tax assessments effective as of December 31, 2018, and continued at market value until the expiration of the Term of this Agreement.

3.3 It is understood and agreed among the parties that, at the end of the Abatement term, the real property must remain on the tax rolls at the full appraised value for a minimum of ten (10) years before the property is eligible for tax abatement again.

**IV.
TERM OF THE AGREEMENT**

4.1 The term of this Agreement (the "Term") shall begin on the date of this Agreement and end upon completion of the final abatement year.

4.2 Prior to December 1st of each year during the Term of this Agreement, OWNER shall certify to the governing body of the CITY, on behalf of each taxing unit, that OWNER is in compliance with all of the terms and conditions of this Agreement.

**V.
DEFAULT AND RECAPTURE OF ABATED TAX**

5.1 In the event that (a) OWNER fails to incur the minimum In Service Project Cost of an amount that, at a minimum, is equal to 20 percent of the most recent valuation of the property, or \$258,000.00, whichever is less; (b) OWNER allows its ad valorem taxes owed the COUNTY to become delinquent and fails to timely and properly follow the legal procedures for protest and/or contest of any such ad valorem taxes; (c) OWNER has an Event of Bankruptcy or Insolvency (as defined in Paragraph 1.2); or (d) OWNER otherwise fails to comply with any of the terms, conditions, or obligations of this Agreement, then this Agreement shall be in default.

5.2 In the event of default, COUNTY shall give the OWNER written notice of such default and, if the OWNER has not cured such default within sixty (60) days after said written notice, this Agreement may be terminated by the COUNTY. If the COUNTY terminates this Agreement in the event of default, OWNER shall repay to the COUNTY all taxes which otherwise would have been paid to the COUNTY without the benefit of abatement during the Term of this Agreement, together with interest at the statutory rate for delinquent taxes as determined by Section 33.01 of the Texas Tax Code (but without the addition of penalty), reasonable attorney's fees, and costs. Such amounts shall be due, owing, and payable to the COUNTY within sixty (60) days after the expiration of the above mentioned 60-day cure period. The parties acknowledge that COUNTY will suffer damages in the event of OWNER's default under this Agreement. The parties acknowledge that actual damages in the event of default and termination would be speculative and difficult to determine. OWNER's obligation to pay any amounts hereunder shall survive termination of this Agreement.

5.3 It is expressly acknowledged and agreed between the parties that the COUNTY shall have the right to place a tax lien against the Property pursuant to Section 32.01 of the Texas Tax Code. Such lien shall secure the payment of all taxes abated and subject to recapture under this Agreement, together with all other amounts payable hereunder. Any such lien may be fully enforced pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Tax Code. Also, to collect any amounts payable hereunder, the COUNTY shall have all other remedies provided generally in the Tax Code for the collection of delinquent property tax.

**VI.
GENERAL PROVISIONS**

6.1 The COUNTY represents and warrants that the Property does not include any property that is owned by a member of the County Commissioners Court approving, or having responsibility for the approval of this Agreement.

6.2 The terms and conditions of the Agreement are binding upon the successors and permitted assigns of all parties hereto. This Agreement may not be assigned by OWNER without the prior written consent of the COUNTY, such consent to be at the sole discretion of the COUNTY; provided, however, that upon written notice to the COUNTY, OWNER may assign its rights under this Agreement to a wholly owned subsidiary of OWNER, subject to OWNER remaining liable for all of its obligations hereunder.

6.3 It is understood and agreed between the parties that the OWNER, in performing its obligations hereunder, is acting independently, and the COUNTY assumes no responsibility or liability in connection therewith to third parties and OWNER agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY therefrom. It is further understood and agreed among the parties that the COUNTY, in performing its obligations hereunder, is acting independently, and the OWNER assumes no responsibility or liability in connection therewith to third parties and the COUNTY agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the OWNER therefrom, to the extent not prohibited by law.

6.4 Notices required to be given to any party to this Agreement shall be given personally or by certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, addressed to the party at its address set forth below, and given by mail, shall be deemed delivered as of the date personally delivered or three days after deposit in the United States mail:

Any party may change the address to which notices are to be sent by giving the other party written notice in the manner provided in this Section.

6.5 This Agreement constitutes the entire and final expression of the agreement of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement can be modified or amended only by a written agreement executed by both parties.

6.6 If either party commences an action against the other party arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the other party reasonable attorneys' fees and costs of suit.

6.7 This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to its choice

of law rules. This Agreement is performable in Navarro County, Texas. Exclusive venue for any litigation related to, or arising out of, this Agreement shall lie in Navarro County, Texas.

6.8 In this Agreement, time is of the essence.

6.9 This Agreement may be executed simultaneously in two or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.



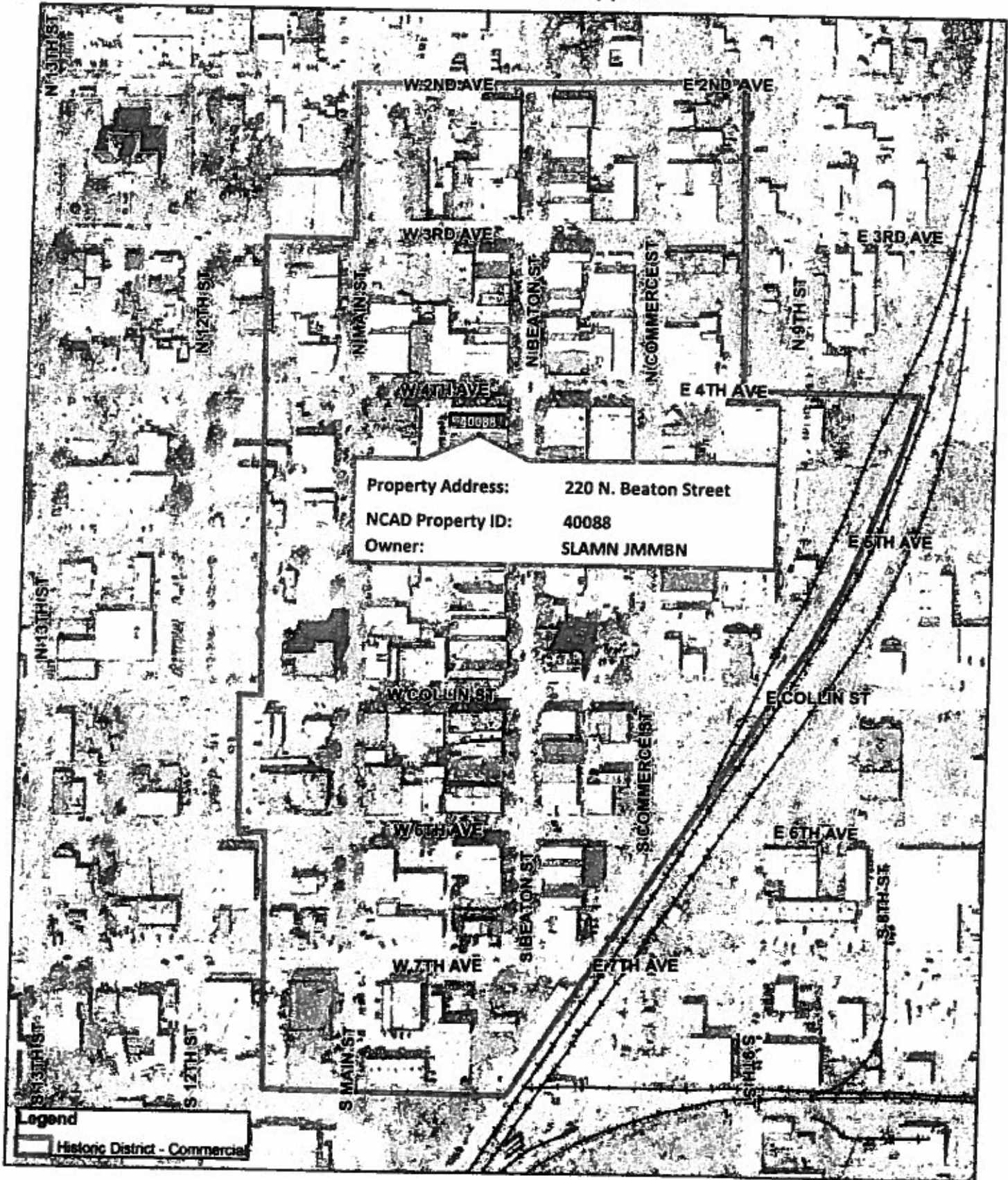

re:SearchTX Participation Agreement

This Participation Agreement is made between Tyler Technologies, Inc. and Client.

WHEREAS, Tyler and the Texas Office of Court Administration (the "OCA") entered into a certain Master Electronic Filing Agreement dated November 8, 2012 (the "2012 OCA eFile Agreement") whereby Tyler has made available to Texas courts Tyler's electronic filing system;

WHEREAS, under the 2012 OCA eFile Agreement, Tyler agreed to develop a document search/retrieval portal to be made available to Users;

WHEREAS, Tyler has developed such portal, re:SearchTX, as further described herein; and,

WHEREAS, Client wishes to make available certain documents and other data to re:SearchTX.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the mutual covenants and promises set forth in this Agreement, Tyler and Client agree as follows:

SECTION A – DEFINITIONS

1. "Agreement" means this Participation Agreement.
2. "Client" means Navarro County, Texas.
3. "Documents" means accepted electronic filings, rulings, opinions, or any other documents that you deem appropriate for access through re:SearchTX.
4. "Effective Date" means the date on which your authorized representative signs the Agreement.
5. "Metadata" means a set of data that describes and gives information about case records and the Documents.
6. "re:SearchTX" or "Tyler Software" means the document search/retrieval portal envisioned by the 2012 OCA eFile Agreement, whereby Users are able to search Metadata stored in the document search/retrieval portal to direct Users to county-stored documents as authorized by the stakeholders owning the records
7. "Tyler" means Tyler Technologies, Inc., a Delaware corporation.
8. "Users" means those users permitted to access re:SearchTX as authorized by the OCA.
9. "we", "us", "our" and similar terms mean Tyler.
10. "you" and similar terms mean Client.
11. "API" or "APIs" is/are Application Programming Interface(s). These are messages which allow data to be communicated from the Client's Odyssey Production Environment to re:SearchTX.

SECTION B – ACCESS and OWNERSHIP

1. **Integrated Method.** We will use our standard APIs to integrate your case management system directly with re:SearchTX, allowing court documents and information to be exchanged between your case management system and re:SearchTX. The APIs will allow security parameters to be exchanged, preventing unauthorized access to confidential court documents and records through re:SearchTX. Tyler will enable this integration and provide access to Users upon the Client's written notice to proceed.
2. **Portal Access.** We will host and provide re:SearchTX to allow Users to search Metadata stored within re:SearchTX that directs Users to Documents you store outside of re:SearchTX. At no cost to the Client, you will provide us with access to the Documents to the extent necessary for us to perform our obligations under this Agreement.
3. **Ownership.**
 - 3.1. You retain all ownership and intellectual property rights to the Documents and Metadata. Nothing in this Agreement shall be deemed to vest in us any ownership rights in and to your Documents and Metadata; provided, however, you grant us a nonexclusive, perpetual, irrevocable, fully paid, royalty-free, license to the Documents and Metadata, consistent with the contemplated use of re:SearchTX under the 2012 OCA eFile Agreement, including any amendments thereto.
 - 3.2. We reserve all rights not expressly granted to you in this Agreement. We own the title, copyright, and other intellectual property rights in Re:SearchTX.

SECTION C – TERM, TERMINATION and DISPUTE RESOLUTION

1. **Term.** The term of this Agreement ("Term") shall commence on the Effective Date and shall continue in accordance with the term set forth in the 2012 OCA eFile Agreement, including all renewals thereof.
2. **Termination for Cause.** Either party may terminate this Agreement for "Cause"; provided, however, that such party follows the procedures set forth in Section C(3). For purposes of this Section C(2), "Cause" means either: (a) a material breach of this Agreement, which has not been cured within thirty (30) days of the date such party receives written notice of such breach; (b) breach of Confidentiality in Section E(8); or (c) If Tyler becomes insolvent or bankrupt, or is the subject of any proceedings relating to its liquidation or insolvency or for the appointment of receiver or similar officer for it, has a receiver of its assets or property appointed or makes an assignment for the benefit of all or substantially all of its creditors, or institutes, or causes to be instituted any proceeding in bankruptcy or reorganization or rearrangement of its affairs.

No party may terminate this Agreement under this Section 2 until it follows the dispute resolution procedures set forth in Section C(3).

3. **Dispute Resolution.** Subject to applicable law, including but not limited to the Texas Public Information Act, you agree to provide us with written notice within thirty (30) days of becoming aware of a dispute. You agree to cooperate with us in trying to reasonably resolve all disputes, including, if requested by either party, appointing a senior representative to meet and engage in good faith negotiations with our appointed senior representative. Senior representatives will convene within thirty (30) days of the written dispute notice, unless otherwise agreed. Except for the Open Meetings Act, all meetings and discussions between senior representatives will be deemed confidential settlement discussions not subject to disclosure under Federal Rule of Evidence 408 or any similar applicable state rule. If we fail to resolve the dispute, either of us may assert our respective rights and remedies in a court of exclusive jurisdiction in

Navarro County, Texas. Nothing in this section shall prevent you or us from seeking necessary injunctive relief during the dispute resolution procedures

SECTION D – INDEMNIFICATION AND LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

1. Intellectual Property Infringement Indemnification.

- 1.1 We will defend, indemnify and hold harmless you and your agents, officials, and employees from and against any third-party claim(s) that the Tyler Software or Documentation infringes that third party's patent, copyright, or trademark, or misappropriates its trade secrets, and will pay the amount of any resulting adverse final judgment (or settlement to which we consent). You must notify us promptly in writing of the claim and give us control over its defense or settlement. You agree to provide us with reasonable assistance, cooperation, and information in defending the claim at our expense.
- 1.2 Our obligations under this Section D(1) will not apply to the extent the claim or adverse final judgment is based on your: (a) use of a previous version of the Tyler Software and the claim would have been avoided had you installed and used the current version of the Tyler Software, and we provided notice of that requirement to you as well as a commercially reasonable timeframe within which to perform the version upgrade; (b) combining the Tyler Software with any product or device not provided, contemplated, or approved by us; (c) altering or modifying the Tyler Software, including any modification by third parties at your direction or otherwise permitted by you; (d) use of the Tyler Software in contradiction of this Agreement, including with non-licensed third parties; or (e) willful infringement or misappropriation, including use of the Tyler Software after we notify you to discontinue use due to such a claim.
- 1.3 If we receive information concerning an infringement or misappropriation claim related to the Tyler Software, we may, at our expense and without obligation to do so, either: (a) procure for you the right to continue its use; (b) modify it to make it non-infringing or non-misappropriating; or (c) replace it with a functional equivalent, in which case you will stop running the allegedly infringing Tyler Software immediately. Alternatively, we may decide to litigate the claim to judgment, in which case you may continue to use the Tyler Software consistent with the terms of this Agreement.
- 1.4 If an infringement or misappropriation claim is fully litigated and your use of the Tyler Software is enjoined by a court of competent jurisdiction, in addition to paying any adverse final judgment (or settlement to which we consent), we will, at our option, either: (a) procure the right to continue its use; (b) modify it to make it non-infringing; (c) replace it with a functional equivalent; or (d) terminate your license and refund the license fees paid for the infringing Tyler Software, as depreciated on a straight-line basis measured over seven (7) years from the Effective Date. We will pursue those options in the order listed herein. This section provides your exclusive remedy for third party copyright, patent, or trademark infringement and trade secret misappropriation claims.

2. **General Indemnification.** We will defend, indemnify and hold harmless you and your agents, officials, and employees from and against any and all third-party claims, losses, liabilities, damages, costs, and expenses (including reasonable attorney's fees and costs) for (a) personal injury or property damage to the extent caused by our negligence or willful misconduct; or (b) our violation of a law applicable to our performance under this Agreement, including our violation of laws relating to the protection of non-

public information regarding minors, mentally ill individuals, and expunged criminal records. You must notify us promptly in writing of the claim and give us sole control over its defense or settlement. You agree to provide us with reasonable assistance, cooperation, and information in defending the claim at our expense.

3. **Limitation of Liability.** OUR LIABILITY TO YOU FOR DAMAGES ARISING OUT OF OR IN CONNECTION WITH THIS AGREEMENT, WHETHER BASED ON A THEORY OF CONTRACT OR TORT, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE AND STRICT LIABILITY, SHALL BE LIMITED TO THE CORRECTION OF DEFECTS IN THE PORTAL. IN NO EVENT SHALL EITHER PARTY BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, OR SPECIAL DAMAGES OF ANY KIND, INCLUDING, WITHOUT LIMITATION, LOST REVENUES OR PROFITS, OR LOSS OF BUSINESS OR LOSS OF DATA ARISING OUT OF THIS AGREEMENT, IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER THE PARTIES HAVE ADVANCE NOTICE OF THE POSSIBILITIES OF SUCH DAMAGE.

SECTION E – GENERAL TERMS

1. **Compliance with Laws.** In providing the services herein, we will comply with all applicable federal, state of Texas, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations.
2. **No Warranty.** You acknowledge that all Documents are received directly from you on an "AS IS" basis, and that we do not edit, and cannot independently verify, the completeness or accuracy of the Documents or Metadata. All Documents retrieved through the re:SearchTX are provided on an "AS IS" basis. Neither party makes any representation or warranty related to the accuracy or completeness of any such Documents and shall have no liability arising from or relating to the same. WE MAKE NO REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY RELATED TO THE PERFORMANCE OF THE PORTAL, AND DISCLAIM ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, INCLUDING THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.
3. **Binding Effect; No Assignment.** This Agreement shall be binding on, and shall be for the benefit of, either your or our successor(s) or permitted assign(s). Except for laws of the State of Texas, neither party may assign this Agreement without the prior written consent of the other party; provided, however, your consent is not required for an assignment by us as a result of a corporate reorganization, merger, acquisition, or purchase of substantially all of our assets.
4. **No Intended Third Party Beneficiaries.** This Agreement is entered into solely for the benefit of you and us. No third party will be deemed a beneficiary of this Agreement, and no third party will have the right to make any claim or assert any right under this Agreement.
5. **Independent Contractor.** We are an independent contractor for all purposes under this Agreement.
6. **Notices.** All notices or communications required or permitted as a part of this Agreement, such as notice of an alleged material breach for a termination for cause or a dispute that must be submitted to dispute resolution, must be in writing and will be deemed delivered upon the earlier of the following: (a) actual receipt by the receiving party; (b) upon receipt by sender of a certified mail, return receipt signed by an employee or agent of the receiving party; (c) upon receipt by sender of proof of email delivery; or (d) if not actually received, five (5) days after deposit with the United States Postal Service authorized mail center with proper postage (certified mail, return receipt requested) affixed and addressed to the other party at the address set forth on the signature page hereto or such other address as the party may have designated by proper notice. The consequences for the failure to receive a notice due to improper notification by the intended receiving party of a change in address will be borne by the intended receiving party.
7. **Client Lists.** You agree that we may identify you by name in client lists, marketing presentations, and promotional materials.

8. **Confidentiality.** Subject to applicable law, including but not limited to the Texas Public Information Act, both parties recognize that their respective employees and agents, in the course of performance of this Agreement, may be exposed to confidential information and that disclosure of such information could violate rights to private individuals and entities, including the parties. Confidential information is nonpublic information that a reasonable person would believe to be confidential and includes, without limitation, non-public information regarding minors, mentally ill individuals, and expunged criminal records; and personal identifying information (e.g., social security numbers) and trade secrets, each as defined by applicable state law. Each party agrees that it will not disclose any confidential information of the other party and further agrees to take all reasonable and appropriate action to prevent such disclosure by its employees or agents. The confidentiality covenants contained herein will survive the termination or cancellation of this Agreement. This obligation of confidentiality will not apply to information that:
- (a) is in the public domain, either at the time of disclosure or afterwards, except by breach of this Agreement by a party or its employees or agents;
 - (b) a party can establish by reasonable proof was in that party's possession at the time of initial disclosure;
 - (c) a party receives from a third party who has a right to disclose it to the receiving party; or
 - (d) is the subject of a legitimate disclosure request under the open records laws or similar applicable public disclosure laws governing this Agreement; provided, however, that in the event you receive an open records or other similar applicable request, you will give us prompt notice and otherwise perform the functions required by applicable law.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, Tyler understands that Client is a unit of local government and therefore is subject to the Texas Public Information Act. Should Client receive a request from a third party for Confidential Information, it shall promptly notify Tyler of such request in writing, including a copy of such request, and shall thereafter assert any applicable exceptions under said Act to the Texas Attorney General for a ruling on whether the requested information must be released. Client shall not be required to institute litigation to challenge a ruling from the Texas Attorney General that the requested information must be released, however, Client shall not impair Tyler's rights to seek protection of Confidential Information in the manner allowed by applicable law. Nothing herein shall be interpreted to abrogate Client's duties under the Public Information Act.

9. **Governing Law and Venue.** This Agreement will be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas, without regard to its rules on conflicts of law. The parties agree that the exclusive venue for any legal proceedings involving this Agreement shall be in Navarro County, Texas.

Any electronic, scanned, photocopied, or similarly reproduced signature on this Agreement or any amendment hereto will be deemed an original signature and will be fully enforceable as if an original signature. Each party represents to the other that the signatory set forth below is duly authorized to bind that party to this Agreement.
11. **Expenses for Enforcement.** In the event either party hereto is required to employ an attorney to enforce the provisions of this agreement or is required to commence legal proceedings to enforce the

provisions hereof, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the other, reasonable attorney's fees and court costs incurred in connection with such enforcement, including collection.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN
THE OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL
AND NAVARRO COUNTY**

This Memorandum of Understanding (the "MOU") is entered into by and between the Office of the Attorney General of Texas (the "OAG") and Navarro County (the "County") in compliance with the provisions of Texas Government Code §771 and Texas Family Code §231.002. In this MOU, the OAG and the County are referred to individually as (a "Party") and collectively as (the "Parties").

1. PURPOSE AND STATEMENT OF SERVICES

In support of the OAG's duties as a Title IV-D agency, the County agrees to provide authorized OAG personnel access to the County District Clerk case management and imaging system ("County Systems").

The OAG will identify OAG personnel with a business need to access County Systems ("Authorized Users"). OAG personnel not identified as Authorized Users are not allowed to access County Systems. Authorized Users will ensure that any County System access information (e.g. User IDs, passwords) is kept secure, in accordance with the OAG's policy regarding system access and safeguarding passwords. The OAG agrees to comply with all OAG policies and applicable laws regarding the confidentiality of information it receives from the County.

2. TERM

This MOU is effective on May 1, 2019 and shall continue until terminated as provided herein.

3. FINANCIAL MATTERS

The Parties assume full responsibility for their respective costs associated with their performance of services under this MOU.

4. NOTICE

Any notice required or permitted to be given under this MOU shall be in writing and shall be addressed to the receiving Party at the address specified below. Notice shall be deemed to have been given immediately if delivered in person to the recipient's address specified below. Notice shall be deemed to have been given on the date of certified receipt if placed in the United States Mail, postage prepaid, by registered or certified mail with return receipt requested, addressed to the receiving Party at the address specified below. Registered or certified mail with return receipt is not required for copies.

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8. TERMINATION

Either Party may terminate this MOU, in whole or in part, without penalty, by providing written notice to the other Party. Said termination will be effective upon receipt of the written notice by the other Party.

If Federal or State laws or regulations or other Federal or State requirements are amended or judicially interpreted so that either Party cannot reasonably fulfill this MOU and if the Parties cannot agree to an amendment that would enable substantial continuation of this MOU, the Parties shall be discharged from any further obligations under this MOU.


Termination of this MOU for any reason shall not release either Party from any liability or obligation set forth in this MOU that is expressly stated to survive any such termination or by its nature would be intended to be applicable following any such termination.
