

AN ORDER OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF NAVARRO COUNTY, TO CREATE AND DESIGNATE REINVESTMENT ZONE 20-101 PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 312, TEXAS TAX CODE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of Navarro County, Texas (the “County”) desire to promote the development of a certain area within its jurisdiction by designating it a reinvestment zone; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to create the proper economic and social environment to induce the investment of private resources in productive business enterprises located in areas of the County and to provide employment to residents of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioners desire to promote the development or redevelopment of a certain geographic area within its jurisdiction by the creation of a reinvestment zone for commercial/industrial reinvestment, as authorized by the Property Redevelopment and Tax Abatement Act, Chapter 312, Texas Tax Code (the “Act”); and

WHEREAS, the County held a public hearing on April 13, 2020, after publishing notice of such hearing, and giving written notice to all taxing units overlapping the territory inside the proposed reinvestment zone; and

WHEREAS, the County, at such hearing, invited any interested person, or his attorney, to appear and contend for or against the creation of the reinvestment zone, whether all or part of the territory described in the ordinance calling such hearing should be included in such proposed reinvestment zone, and considered the concept of tax abatement; and

WHEREAS, by the approval of a Resolution on October 22, 2018, the County has approved Tax Abatement Guidelines, Criteria and Policies; and

WHEREAS, it is the belief of the County that the premises do not include any property that is owned or leased by a member of the Commissioners Court or any other board or commission of the County having responsibility for the approval of the agreement. The parties recognize, and understand, that any property so owned is excluded by law from the property tax abatement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF NAVARRO COUNTY TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1.

FINDINGS OF COMMISSIONERS

The County, after conducting such hearings and having heard such evidence and testimony, has made the following finding and determinations based upon the testimony presented to it:

- A. That a public hearing on the adoption of the reinvestment zone has been properly called, held and conducted and that notices of such hearings have been published as required by

law and delivered to all taxing units overlapping the territory inside the proposed reinvestment zone; and

- B. That the boundaries of the reinvestment zone should be described and depicted in the attached Exhibit "A and B"; and
- C. That the creation of the reinvestment zone for commercial/industrial tax abatement with the boundaries as described in Exhibits "A and B" will result in benefits to the County and to the land included in the zone, the improvements sought are feasible and practical, and would be a benefit to the land included in the reinvestment zone after the expiration of an agreement entered into under Section 312.204 of the Act; and
- D. That the reinvestment zone defined in Exhibits "A and B" meets the criteria for the creation of a reinvestment zone as set forth in Section 312.201 of the Act; and
- E. That it would reasonably be likely, as a result of the designation, to contribute to the retention or expansion of primary employment or to attract major investment in the reinvestment zone that would contribute to the economic development of the county.


SECTION 2.

This Resolution shall become effective from and after its passage.

SECTION 3.

The zone shall take effect on the effective date of this Resolution and shall be in effect for five (5) years from that date, unless a longer period is authorized by law.

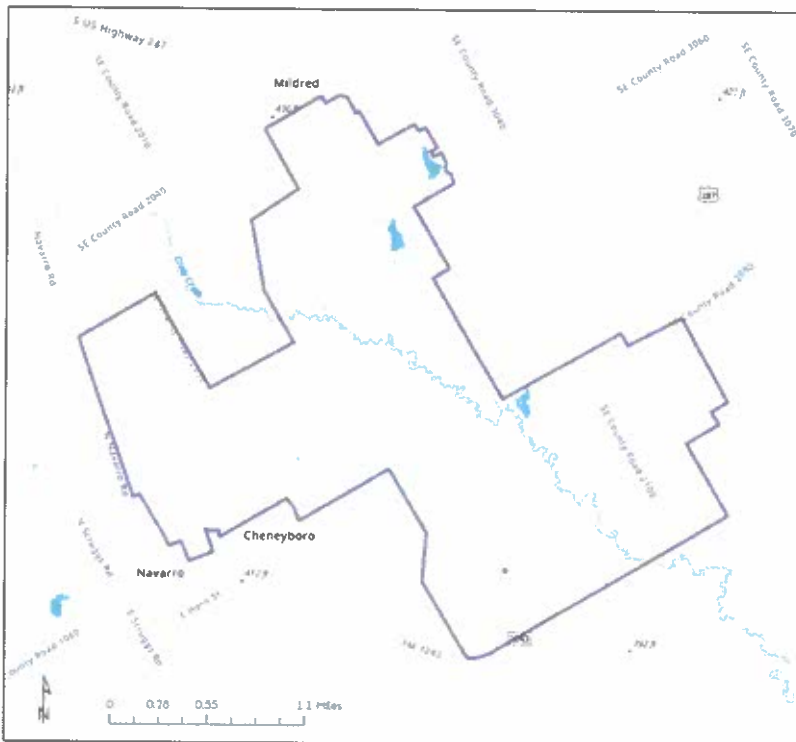

QEI INSPECTION

We will arrange for the performance of the annual QEI State Inspection and on your elevator(s) at the above-referenced building. A QEI Certified State Inspector, with the assistance of additional manpower as necessary, will perform the inspection. We will be responsible for the coordination of the inspection, notification to the State of the inspection, transportation, scheduling, handling, and processing of the associated paperwork. Following the inspection, you will receive the certificate of inspection for each elevator. We will also provide you with proposals for work required, if any, to correct any deficiencies/violations noted on the certificate of inspection. In the event that some or all required work is covered under the terms of your current contract, we will supply you with a letter detailing the work to be performed.

Once you have received the certificates of inspection, you are responsible for filing the certificate of inspection (one (1) per elevator or escalator) and the \$20.00 per elevator/escalator fee with the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation. Should you wish to seek a waiver or delay with respect to any violation indicated by the inspection, you are responsible for requesting such waiver or delay. There is a fee of \$50.00 for each application for delay or waiver. If you were to apply for both a waiver and delay, then the fee would be \$100.00. Please note that the certificates of inspection (or requests for waiver or delay) must be filed with the state within 30 days of the date of inspection.

You hereby acknowledge that by this proposal Otis Elevator Company is subcontracting certain of its duties under its current contract including the duty to perform an annual pressure relief valve test/no load test. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. This quotation is subject to change or withdrawal by us prior to acceptance by you.
 2. The work shall be performed for the agreed price plus any applicable sales, excise or similar taxes as required by law. In addition to the agreed price, you shall pay to us any future applicable tax imposed on us, our suppliers or you in connection with the performance of the work described.
 3. Payments shall be made as follows: A down payment of zero percent (0 %) of the price shall be paid by you upon your signing of this document. Full payment shall be made on completion if the work is completed within a thirty day period. If the work is not completed within a thirty day period, monthly progress payments shall be made based on the value of any equipment ready or delivered, if any, and labor performed through the end of the month less a five percent (5%) retainage and the aggregate of previous payments. The retainage shall be paid when the work is completed. We reserve the right to discontinue our work at any time until payments shall have been made as agreed and we have assurance satisfactory to us that subsequent payments will be made when due. Payments not received within thirty (30) days of the date of invoice shall be subject to interest accrued at the rate of eighteen percent (18%) per annum or at the maximum rate allowed by applicable law, whichever is less. We shall also be entitled to reimbursement from you of the expenses, including attorney's fees, incurred in collecting any overdue payments.
 4. Our performance is conditioned upon your securing any required governmental approvals for the installation of any equipment provided hereunder and your providing our workmen with a safe place in which to work. Additionally, you agree to notify us if you are aware or become aware prior to the completion of the work of the existence of asbestos or other hazardous material in any elevator hoistway, machine room, hallway or other place in the building where Otis personnel are or may be required to perform their work. In the event it should become necessary to abate, encapsulate or remove asbestos or other hazardous materials from the building, you agree to be responsible for such abatement, encapsulation or removal, and in such event Otis shall be entitled to delay its work until it is determined to our satisfaction that no hazard exists and compensation for delays encountered if such delay is more than sixty (60) days. In any event, we reserve the right to discontinue our work in the building whenever in our opinion this provision is being violated.
 5. Unless otherwise agreed in writing, it is understood that the work shall be performed during our regular working hours of our regular working days. If overtime work is mutually agreed upon and performed, an additional charge therefore, at our usual rates for such work, shall be added to the contract price. The performance of our work hereunder is conditioned on your performing the preparatory work and supplying the necessary data specified on the front of this proposal or in the attached specification, if any. Should we be required to make an unscheduled return to your site to begin or complete the work due to your request, acts or omissions, then such return visits shall be subject to additional charges at our then current labor rates.
 6. Title to any material to be furnished hereunder shall pass to you when final payment for such material is received. In addition, we shall retain a security interest in all material furnished hereunder and not paid for in full. You agree that a copy of this Agreement may be used as a financing statement for the purpose of placing upon public record our interest in any material furnished hereunder, and you agree to execute a UCC -1 form or any other document reasonably requested by us for that purpose.
 7. Except insofar as your equipment may be covered by an Otis maintenance or service contract, it is agreed that we will make no examination of your equipment other than that necessary to do the work described in this contract and assume no responsibility for any part of your equipment except that upon which work has been done under this contract.
 8. Neither party shall be liable to the other for any loss, damage or delay due to any cause beyond either parties reasonable control, including but not limited to acts of government, strikes, lockouts, other labor disputes, fire, explosion, theft, weather damage, flood, earthquake, riot, civil commotion, war, mischief or act of God.
 9. We warrant that all services furnished will be performed in a workmanlike manner. We also warrant that any equipment provided hereunder shall be free from defects in workmanship and material. Our sole responsibility under this warranty shall be at our option to correct any defective services and to either repair or replace any component of the equipment found to be defective in workmanship or material provided that written notice of such defects shall have been given to us by you within ninety (90) days after completion of the work or such longer period as may be indicated on the front of this form. All defective parts that are removed and replaced by us shall become our property. We do not agree under this warranty to bear the cost of repairs or replacements due to vandalism, abuse, misuse, neglect, normal wear and tear, modifications not performed by us, improper or insufficient maintenance by others, or any causes beyond our control. We shall conduct, at our own expense, the entire defense of any claim, suit or action alleging that, without further combination, the use by you of any equipment provided hereunder directly infringes any patent, but only on the conditions that (a) we receive prompt written notice of such claim, suit or action and full opportunity and authority to assume the sole defense thereof, including settlement and appeals, and all information available to you for such defense; (b) said equipment is made according to a specification or design furnished by us; and (c) the claim, suit or action is brought against you. Provided all of the foregoing conditions have been met, we shall, at our own expense, either settle said claim, suit or action or shall pay all damages excluding consequential damages and costs awarded by the court therein and, if the use or resale of such equipment is finally enjoined, we shall, at our option, (i) procure for you the right to use the equipment, (ii) replace the equipment with equivalent noninfringing equipment, (iii) modify the equipment so it becomes noninfringing but equivalent, or (iv) remove the equipment and refund the purchase price (if any) less a reasonable allowance for use, damage and obsolescence.
- THE EXPRESS WARRANTIES SET FORTH IN THIS ARTICLE 9 ARE THE EXCLUSIVE WARRANTIES GIVEN; WE MAKE NO OTHER WARRANTIES EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, AND SPECIFICALLY MAKE NO WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR OF FITNESS FOR ANY PARTICULAR PURPOSE, AND THE EXPRESS WARRANTIES SET FORTH IN THIS ARTICLE ARE IN LIEU OF ANY SUCH WARRANTIES AND ANY OTHER OBLIGATION OR LIABILITY ON OUR PART.



RETAINER AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into this 8 day of June, 2020, by and between NAVARRO County, Texas, hereinafter referred to as "Client", and Allison, Bass & Magee, L.L.P. hereinafter referred to as "Attorneys".

Recitals

The Client is a political subdivision of the State of Texas. The Attorneys are duly licensed to practice law in the State of Texas and desire to render their professional services for the Client as provided herein.

The Commissioners Court of NAVARRO County, Texas, acting in its judicial and executive capacity, finds that the public interest requires the retention of legal counsel to represent the County in the referenced matters.

THEREFORE, the Client hereby engages the services of the Attorneys, and in consideration of the mutual promises herein contained, the parties agree as follows:

Services of Attorney

1. The Attorneys will advise and represent the Client in legal and administrative matters as requested by the Client, by and through a majority vote of the Commissioners Court, for consultation and assistance with the 2020 County Transportation Infrastructure Fund (CTIF 2020) grant application and administration of grant funds, and on such legal matters as may be assigned by the Commissioners Court. Services will also include drafting and reviewing of documents, briefing, and any negotiations required for resolution of this matter.

2. This Retainer Agreement shall serve as the basis for understanding regarding fees and costs to be charged to the Client, but the subject matter for legal services may only be authorized by an Order of the Commissioners Court.

3. Fees will include any and all necessary research, drafting and reviewing of documents, briefing, and any negotiations required for the proper disposition of any and all matters entrusted to the Attorneys pursuant to this retainer agreement.

Compensation

4. For the services described in Paragraph 1, the Client agrees to pay the Attorneys a sum equal to not more than 5% of the County grant allocation, but not to exceed \$25,000.00 for all services and expenses incurred by the firm. Based on the estimated grant application information issued by the Texas Transportation Commission on 3/26/2020, NAVARRO County will receive an estimated award of \$159,360.00 upon a successful application. The County will be required to provide a match of \$31,872.00 from available county revenues. Our fee will be \$7,968.00. Upon approval of the county application by TXDOT, this fee will be submitted for grant reimbursement as an administrative expense for project administration.

Devotion of Time

5. The Attorneys shall make themselves available for consultation with the Client at reasonable times, at the request of the Client.

Term

6. This agreement shall be effective on the execution hereof by Client and shall continue in effect until the matter has been finally resolved or upon 30 days written notice by either party. The Client shall send notice to the Attorneys' office at 402 West 12th Street, Austin, Texas 78701, and the Attorneys shall send notice to the Client care of the County Judge, 300 W. 3rd Ave., Ste. 102, Corsicana, Texas 75110.




