

COVID-19 ORDER #3

Based on the First Emergency Order Regarding The COVID-19 State of Disaster issued by the Supreme Court of Texas (Misc. Docket No. 20-9042), the Court of Criminal Appeals of Texas (Misc. Docket No. 20-007), recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and the Office of Court Administration, the Court orders that no more than 10 people are allowed in the courtroom. The number allowed includes court staff. Parties and counsel can come into the courtroom when their case is called and will have to leave the courtroom at the end of their case. All other parties and counsel will have to remain outside the courtroom until their case is called. Furthermore, the Court orders that this order be posted at the Navarro County Courthouse, the Navarro County website, and sent to all parties and counsel.
