Martin Ritchey explains that a rescue boat was acquired and but there was nowhere for the county to store it so they spoke with the city of Lockhart about storing it at the Bufkin Lane facility, Fire Station. Emergency management and all other county departments will have easy access from this location. The county and city entered into an agreement and he recommends approval.

Motion made by Commissioner Muñoz, second by Commissioner Moses to approve the Resolution. All voting "Aye".

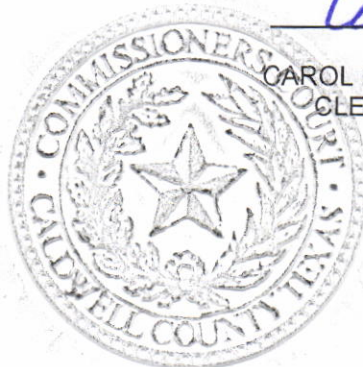




