As per Interlocal Agreement between Hockley County and Texas Division of Emergency Management recorded below.

**INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
BETWEEN HOCKLEY COUNTY AND
TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT**

This Interlocal Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into between Hockley County located in Hockley County, Texas ("County"), and Texas Division of Emergency Management, a member of the Texas A&M University System, an agency of the State of Texas (TDEM) for the purpose of facilitating the provision of emergency services.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Texas Government Code Chapter 791, as amended, cities, counties, special districts and other legally constituted political subdivisions of the State of Texas are authorized to enter into local contracts and agreements with each other regarding governmental functions and services; and

WHEREAS TDEM personnel require a location from which they may operate to coordinate state emergency response, recovery, preparedness, and mitigation efforts; and

WHEREAS, TDEM has requested that space be made available to it for its personnel and;

WHEREAS the County has determined there is available space to accommodate TDEM's request in the Hockley County Memorial Library located at 811 Austin Street, Levelland, Texas, Hockley County;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein and subject to the conditions herein set forth, the County and TDEM hereby agree as follows.

I. COUNTY AGREEMENTS

To accomplish the purposes of this Agreement, the County and TDEM agree to the following:

- 1) The County will provide office space to TDEM personnel in which they can conduct routine functions connected with their emergency management efforts at the Hockley County Court House Basement located at 802 Houston Street, Levelland, Texas, Hockley County. The County may change the location of the designated office space. TDEM staff may utilize the staff restrooms, unreserved parking spaces and any other common spaces in the building.
- 2) The County will maintain the space and provide electrical, water, gas, and air conditioning services.
- 3) The County reserves the right to utilize the workspace for its own purposes and the access granted to TDEM is not exclusive.
- 4) The County will provide a key to the building to allow TDEM personnel 24 hours access to the facility; at the termination of this agreement the key will be returned to the County.

II. TDEM AGREEMENTS

- 5) TDEM will identify to the County a local point of contact who will communicate with the County related to the use of the premises under this Agreement. TDEM's current point of contact is Bill Durham, William.durham@tdem.texas.gov.
- 6) TDEM agrees that it will be utilizing the space provided in furtherance of their emergency management duties for the State.
- 7) TDEM will advise the County as soon as practicable when its personnel shall be utilizing the premises provided under this agreement.
- 8) TDEM personnel will be providing all their own equipment and communications devices and will access state computer programs utilizing their own equipment. TDEM agrees that no access to the County computer system will be required or requested at any time.
- 9) While located at the County premises, TDEM personnel shall perform their duties in a manner so as to not interfere with the ordinary functioning of public safety activities of the police fire and EMS personnel of the County.

III. JOINT AGREEMENTS

- 10) No charge for the use of the premises under this agreement will be made to TDEM by the County and TDEM will not make a claim for providing services under this agreement.
- 11) The employees of each of the parties under this Agreement shall at all times continue to be employees of their employing entity, and there shall be no claim by either entity that any of their employees are considered to be borrowed servants working for the other entity. Each entity under this Agreement will be responsible for the acts and omissions of its own employees performing services under this Agreement. An employee of either entity injured during the performance of duties under this Agreement shall be provided benefits by the employing agency.
- 12) This agreement shall be effective beginning July 1, 2022 and shall remain in effect until June 30, 2023.
- 13) Notwithstanding anything herein to the contrary, this Agreement shall remain in force at the pleasure of either entity; either entity may terminate this Agreement upon the issuance of a thirty-day notice to the other entity. The County may terminate with no notice upon a change of TDEM personnel at the location. The parties may provide notice to the following addresses:


- 14) This is the entire agreement between the parties; no oral representations made by either party to this Agreement not reduced to writing herein shall be of any effect whatsoever.
