WHEREAS, the Hockley County Judge did determine that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property and did issue a Disaster Declaration on May 29, 2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED AND APPROVED by the Hockley County Commissioners Court that the Disaster Declaration issued on May 29, 2024 by the Hockley County Judge is hereby renewed for thirty (30) days from June 4, 2024 pursuant to 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code unless renewed, extended, amended or canceled by the Hockley County Commissioners Court.

Pursuant to 418.018(c) of the Texas Government Code, this Disaster Declaration Renewal shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Hockley County Clerk.

Pursuant to 418.018(d) of the Texas Government Code, this Disaster Declaration Renewal continues activation of the Hockley County Emergency Management Plan; and all local or inter-jurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration.
