Agreement with the City of Levelland, as per Agreement recorded below.

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FIRE SERVICE AGREEMENT

This Agreement is made by and between the CITY OF LEVELAND, TEXAS (the CITY), and the COUNTY OF HOCKLEY (the COUNTY) for the purposes and in accordance with the provisions herein set forth;

1. This Agreement is made under the authority of, and in accordance with the provisions of, TEXAS LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE Chapter 352, County Fire Protection, and Texas Government Code. Chapter 791, the Interlocal Cooperation Act. The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for fire protection in the portion of the County that is situated outside of the municipal boundaries of the City, because the CITY owns and operates a Fire Department as a department of its municipal government, but the COUNTY neither owns or operates any fire-fighting equipment, nor does it provide any type of fire protection, except as hereinafter set forth.

2. The CITY hereby agrees to provide fire-fighting services for the portion of the COUNTY situated outside the municipal boundaries of the CITY, using its equipment and personnel, subject to the following limitations:

A. The particular equipment and the number of personnel dispatched to any fire shall be within the sole discretion of, the CITY's Fire Chief or his designee, taking into account such factors as (but not limited to), the size and type of the fire, the location of the fire, any special toxic or other high risk characteristics of the fire, its proximity to the other departments capable of responding, and the necessity of holding sufficient fire-fighting assets in reserve to respond to other fires that would require a response by the CITY's Fire Department.

B. This Agreement does not include the CITY's providing of fire prevention services, such as building or fire extinguisher inspections, risk assessments, public fire prevention or safety programs, or arson or suspicious circumstances investigations.

3. The COUNTY has provided equipment to, and made arrangements with, numerous irrigation well owners so that those wells can provide water to fire fighting equipment. The COUNTY shall be responsible for maintaining those well connections, and will provide the CITY with appropriate maps or other means for locating and using these wells to obtain necessary water.

7. The term of this Agreement is for one year, commencing on December 1, 2014 and ending on November 30, 2015, subject to the review and approval for subsequent years as outlined in paragraph 6. above. The parties agree that this agreement represents an obligation of 2015 fiscal year funds only.

6. The CITY and COUNTY each acknowledge that they have undertaken a comprehensive review of the costs of providing fire protection services to the citizens of the COUNTY, including those living inside and outside of the CITY, in order that those costs can be equitably borne. The CITY's and COUNTY's representatives have met, and the parties hereto agree that the conditions and responsibilities outlined in this agreement will likely serve as an equitable arrangement for another year. However, periodically the parties shall again undertake a comprehensive review of fire protection services and develop a new or revised fire service agreement when appropriate.

C. For each County Fire Run in excess of 200 the COUNTY shall pay an additional \$600, with the calendar year total not to exceed a total COUNTY obligation of \$140,000. Payment for these runs shall be made as soon as practicable after receipt of the CITY report documenting the runs.

B. The CITY shall periodically provide to the COUNTY reports on the number County Fire runs with each report to include a cumulative total for the calendar year.

A. An annual minimum amount of \$120,000 to cover up to 200 County Fire Runs. This amount shall be paid in two equal installments, the first installment of \$60,000 being paid to the CITY as soon as practicable after January 1, 2015, and the second \$60,000 installment as soon as practicable after July 1, 2015.

5. In consideration of the CITY's providing fire-fighting services, the COUNTY agrees to pay to the CITY:

4. The CITY presently may be a party to one or more Mutual Aid Fire Agreements with other cities, which essentially provide for coordinated fire responses. Those Agreements are not affected by this Agreement, and are not made a part hereof.

8. This Agreement supersedes all previous agreements of the parties concerning the subject matter hereof.

Motion by Judge Larry Sprows, seconded by Commissioner Thrash, 4 Votes Yes, 0 Votes No, that Commissioners' Court to increase dispute resolution fees from \$10.00 to \$15.00 on civil cases, as per Civil Practice and Remedies Code recorded below.

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Request to raise ADR Fee from the current \$10 to \$15

The Office of South Plains Alternative Dispute Resolution has requested that we raise our fee from the current 10 dollars to the maximum 15 dollars in each civil case filed in a county or district court. The monies we collect will be held in the Hockley County ADR fund and we will pay The Office of South Plains Alternative Dispute Resolution as they bill us case by case.

Alternative Dispute Resolution Systems and Financing Act: the Texas legislature passed the Alternative Dispute Resolution Systems and Financing Act which authorizes the commissioners court of each county to "establish an alternative dispute resolution system for the peaceable and expeditious resolution of citizen disputes." This act defines an alternative dispute resolution system as a "forum in which mediation, conciliation, or arbitration is used to resolve disputes among individuals". In order to establish and maintain such programs, the act authorizes each county's commissioners court to tax an additional cost, not to exceed fifteen dollars, on the filing fee in certain civil cases.

TITLE 7. ALTERNATE METHODS OF DISPUTE RESOLUTION

CHAPTER 152. ALTERNATIVE DISPUTE RESOLUTION SYSTEM ESTABLISHED BY COUNTIES

Sec. 152.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "alternative dispute resolution system" means an informal forum in which mediation, conciliation, or arbitration is used to resolve disputes among individuals, entities, and units of government, including those having an ongoing relationship such as relatives, neighbors, landlords and tenants, employees and employers, and merchants and consumers.

Sec. 152.002. ESTABLISHMENT. (a) The commissioners court of a county by order may establish an alternative dispute resolution system for the peaceable and expeditious resolution of disputes.

(b) The commissioners court may do all necessary acts to make the alternative dispute resolution system effective,

- (1) contracting with a private nonprofit corporation, a political subdivision, a public corporation, or a combination of these entities for the purpose of administering the system; making reasonable rules relating to the system, including rules specifying whether criminal cases may be referred to the system; and
- (2) vesting management of the system in a committee selected by the county bar association.

(c) The actions of a committee authorized by subsection (b) (3) are subject to the approval of the commissioners court.

Sec. 152.003. REFERRAL OF CASES. (a) A judge of a

district court, county court, statutory county court, probate court, or justice of the peace court in a county in which an

alternative dispute resolution system has been established may, on motion of a party or on the judge's or justice's own motion,

refer a civil or, if the system accepts criminal cases and on the request of an attorney representing the state, a criminal

case to the system regardless of whether the defendant in the criminal case has been formally charged. Referral under this

section does not prejudice the case.

(b) Before requesting a referral of a criminal case under this section, an attorney representing the state must obtain the consent of the victim and the defendant to the referral.

(c) A criminal case may not be referred to the system if the defendant is charged with or convicted of an offense listed in Section 3g(a)(1), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, or convicted of an offense, the judgment for which contains an affirmative finding under Section 3g(a)(2), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure.

(a) To establish and maintain an alternative dispute resolution system, the commissioners court may set a court cost in an amount not to exceed \$15 to be taxed, collected, and paid as other court costs in each civil case filed in a county or district court in the county, including a civil case relating to probate matters but not including:

- (1) a suit for delinquent taxes;
- (2) a condemnation proceeding under Chapter 21, Property Code; or
- (3) a proceeding under Subtitle C, Title 7, Health and Safety Code.

(b) The county is not liable for the payment of a court cost under this section.

(c) The clerks of the courts in the county shall collect and pay the costs to the county treasurer or, if the county does not have a treasurer, to the county officer who performs the functions of the treasurer, who shall deposit the costs in a separate fund known as the alternative dispute resolution system

fund. The fund shall be administered by the commissioners court and may only be used to establish and maintain the system. The system shall be operated at one or more convenient and accessible places in the county.

(1) a suit for delinquent taxes; or
(2) an eviction proceeding, including a forcible detainer, a forcible entry and detainer, or a writ of re-entry.
(b) A clerk of the court shall collect and pay the court cost in the manner prescribed by Section 152.004(c).

Sec. 152.007. PARTICIPANT FEE FOR CRIMINAL DISPUTE

RESOLUTION. (a) An entity that provides services for the resolution of criminal disputes under this chapter may collect a reasonable fee set by the commissioners court from a person who receives the services, not to exceed \$350, except that a fee may not be collected from an alleged victim of the crime.

(b) Fees collected under this section may be paid on a periodic basis or on a deferred payment schedule at the discretion of the judge, magistrate, or program director administering the pretrial victim-offender mediation program. The fees must be based on the defendant's ability to pay.






Commissioner, Precinct No. 1




Commissioner, Precinct No. 2




Commissioner, Precinct No. 3
