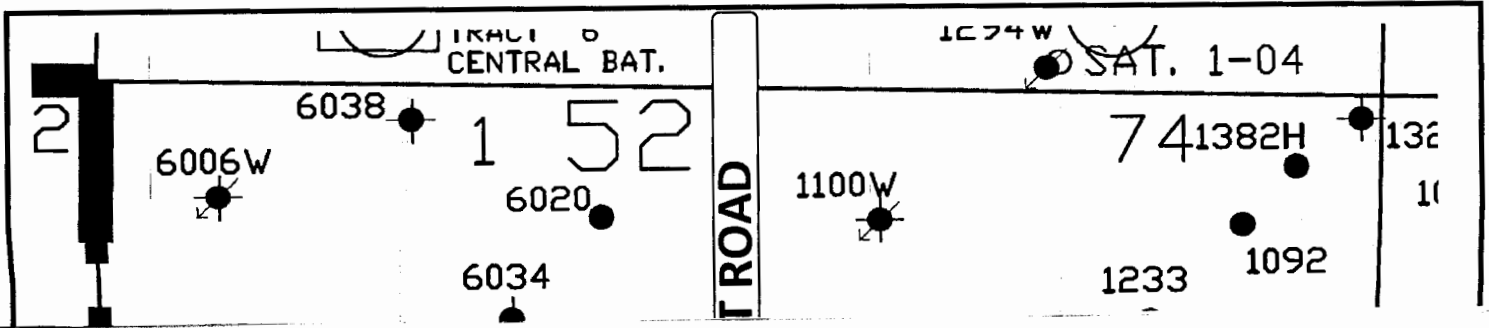


1. Read for approval the minutes of two Special Meetings of the Commissioners Court held Monday, August 17, 2015.



ORDER



This cause coming on to be upon the petition of CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner". The Board finds that in order that Petitioner may carry out its corporate objects and powers, it is necessary for it to lay, construct, operate and maintain pipelines across certain county roads situated in Hockley County, Texas, as set forth in the Petitioner's application filed herein.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, subject to the conditions herein after set forth, said Petitioner, CHEVRON U.S.A. INC. is hereby granted permission and authority to lay, construct, operate and maintain pipelines across certain county roads at the locations set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B" attached to the application of Petitioner herein, which Exhibits "A" and "B" and application are hereby made a part of this order as fully as if set out in length herein provided.

1. The Petitioner shall, in constructing said pipelines undercrossing cause the very minimum of inconvenience and obstruction of public travel along said roads, and, further, shall operate and maintain said pipelines undercrossing in a manner so as not to inconvenience, endanger or obstruct public travel along said roads.
2. Upon the completion of each pipelines undercrossing constructed hereunder Petitioner shall immediately backfill, re-construct and replace the portions of the roads across which said pipelines are laid and constructed so that such roads shall be in equally as good a condition as prior to such construction.
3. So long as said pipelines are maintained and operated under said roads Petitioner shall be responsible for doing any work which, due to the existence of said pipelines undercrossings, needs to be done on said roads at the location thereof, all in order to maintain said roads, at such points, in a condition equal to other portions of said county roads.
4. Should Petitioner remove said pipelines from any of said roads, it will replace and recondition the road concerned, at the location of said removal, in substantially the same condition as it was prior to such removal, all liability of Petitioner for the maintenance and reconditioning of such roads shall cease as soon after such removal as the COUNTY OF HOCKLEY has approved the maintenance and reconditioning work done by Petitioner.
5. Petitioner agrees that if at any time the County of Hockley shall deem it necessary to make any improvements or changes on all of or any part of the right of way of the county roads which affect the Utility as located under this order, then and in such event, the Petitioner or his Assignee shall make such reasonable changes of its facilities located within such right of way as may be deemed necessary, such work to be done without cost to Hockley County, Texas.
6. The construction or laying of said pipelines by Petitioner hereunder shall be considered and shall constitute and acceptance of this order and of all of the terms and conditions herein set forth.
7. Petitioner agrees that if at any time the County of Hockley deems it necessary that these crossings be encased in accordance with the then existing State Highway specifications, Petitioner agrees to do so at its own expense.




Applications can be requested in the basement of the County Library Building, at 811-B Austin Street, in Levelland, Hockley County, Texas. Assistance in completing the application will be provided if needed. Contact the Hockley County Indigent Health Care and Public Assistance Office, 894-4264.


Hockley County will use rules and procedures found in the County Indigent Health Care Program Handbook published by the Texas Department of Health. The handbook is available on line at <http://www.dshs.state.tx.us/cihcp> In summary, rules are:

1. Application forms must be COMPLETELY filled out.
2. Verification of income, termination of income, residence, household composition, and resources is required.
3. Net income cannot exceed limits as determined by the Texas Department of Health.
4. Eligible persons must be a resident of Hockley County.
5. Applicant must provide all information and documentation requested, or application will be denied.
6. Applicants have the right to appeal adverse decisions.

CAUTION: Presenting false information or securing medical benefits wrongfully may subject applicant to criminal and civil penalties. Eligible applicants must report any change in income, resources, household composition, address, and other circumstances affecting eligibility within 14 days to prevent the filing of criminal or civil charges against them.


The effective date of the above rules and procedures is September 1, 2015.
