## Independence Day Fun Facts

- ◆ Congress made Independence Day an official unpaid holiday for federal employees in 1870
- ◆ In 1938, Congress made Independence Day a paid federal holiday
- ◆ The Declaration of Independence was signed by 56 men from 13 colonies
- ◆ Two of the 56 signers of the Declaration of Independence served as President of the United States; John Adams and Thomas Jefferson
- ◆ Originally, Benjamin Franklin proposed the turkey as the national bird, but Thomas Jefferson overruled him by recommending the bald eagle as the national bird
- ◆ On July 4th of every year, the Liberty Bell in Philadelphia is tapped 13 times in honor of the original 13 colonies
