5. Discussion with action to approve the submittal of the FY 2024/2025 E9-1-1 Public Safety Answering Point Services Interlocal Agreement. The Commission on State Emergency Communications (CSEC) rules specify that an Interlocal Agreement is to be established documenting the relationship between the Presidio County, Texas and the Rio Grande Council of Governments for its E9-1-1 public services.

6. Discussion with action to approve an Interlocal Agreement with the Far West Texas Regional Public Defenders Office. Culberson County shall operate the FWTRPDO on behalf of all participating Counties. The FWTRPDO is funded by a Texas Indigent Defense Commission grants and funds contributed by each participating County. Presidio County shall participate in the FWTRPDO. The FWTRPDO will provide court-appointed counsel to adults in Presidio County accused of felonies or misdemeanors punishable by confinement and who are to poor to afford to hire their own attorney.

Option A - No Change. Presidio County will charge the same fees in (CY) 2024

Option B – Add a \$1.50 to Vehicle Registration for “Child Safety Fee”.

May not exceed \$1.50. Revenue must be used for school crossing guard services, remaining funds must be used for programs to enhance child safety, health, or nutrition, including child abuse, intervention and prevention, and drug and alcohol abuse prevention, among other purposes.


