

RESOLUTION

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LIBERTY COUNTY, TEXAS, EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF DISASTER ISSUED BY ORDER OF COUNTY JUDGE ON MARCH 13, 2020 IN RESPONSE TO COVID-19

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, County Judge, Jay Knight, issued an Executive Order Declaring a State of Emergency pursuant to Chapter 418 of the Texas Government Code to alleviate the suffering of people and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout the County of Liberty; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating such disaster declaration continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Liberty County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to prevent the spread of COVID-19 throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 418.108(b), Texas Government Code, a local state disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven (7) days without the consent of the governmental body of the political subdivision;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF LIBERTY COUNTY, TEXAS, THAT:


Section 1. The declaration disaster, which was signed and executed by the County Judge on March 13, 2020, and continues to be effective through March 20, 2020, shall hereby be renewed and extended an additional thirty (30) days through April 19, 2020, as authorized by Section 418.018 of the Texas Government Code.
