

Job Title: Laborer

Job Description:

The Liberty County Precinct #4 Road & Bridge Department is seeking a dedicated Laborer to assist with the construction, maintenance, and repair of county roads and infrastructure. This is a labor-intensive position. Applicants should expect to perform manual labor daily, including digging, shoveling, lifting, loading and unloading materials, clearing brush, cleaning culverts, maintaining roads and rights-of-way, and working outdoors in all weather conditions.

While employees may occasionally operate county equipment when qualified and authorized, this position is primarily a labor position and is not solely an equipment operator position.

Applicants must be physically capable of performing strenuous outdoor work, standing for extended periods, lifting and carrying heavy objects, cleaning culverts, and working in hot, cold, wet, dusty, and uneven terrain conditions.

Employees will perform a variety of assigned tasks and must be willing to perform all duties necessary to support Road & Bridge operations.

Duties & Responsibilities:

- Follow safety guidelines and traffic control procedures while working on public roadways
- Utilize and maintain tools and equipment such as shovels, rakes, string trimmers, mowers, vehicles, roller, plate compactors, traffic control devices, and other related tools and equipment
- Perform road maintenance tasks, including pothole repair, ditch clearing, and brush removal
- Assist with concrete work, asphalt patching, and gravel road upkeep
- Maintain equipment by checking fluid levels, lubricating parts, and reporting maintenance needs
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Road & Bridge Supervisor

Minimum Qualifications:

- High school diploma or GED preferred
- Ability to perform physical labor, strength and stamina to stand for long periods, repeatedly lift heavy objects (up to 50 lbs.) throughout the workday, and work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Possession of a valid Texas Class C driver's license
- Must pass a background check and drug screening

Salary & Benefits:

- Competitive wage (depending on experience)
- County benefits package, including health insurance, retirement plan, and paid time off
- Opportunities for comp time and career advancement
