The increased amounts (up to \$3,000 each) will be at the discretion of the department head, and a payroll change form must be submitted to Brandi Hill for each employee by 10/4/2024.

Commissioner Workman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Foley, to increase the part-time hourly rate for part-time employees working at each Leon County Transfer Station (trash collection sites) to \$20 an hour, effective the first payroll period of the 2024-2025 budget.

MOTION CARRIED.

Judge Ryder made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Workman, to increase the part-time hourly rate for regular part-time employees to \$18 an hour, effective the first payroll period of the 2024-2025 budget.

MOTION CARRIED.

Commissioner Workman made a motion, seconded by Commissioner Foley, to divide the road and bridge funding so that each of the four precincts will receive 25 percent of the fund for the 2024-2025 budget year.
