To the Citizens of Leon County:

Mailing of Voter Registration Certificates Delayed

The Leon County Elections Department, along with counties across the state, are diligently working with the Texas Secretary of State's Office to mail out renewal voter registration certificates for 2026-2027, however, due to the state's redevelopment of the voter registration system, delays across the state are inevitable. The state implemented a major software redevelopment of the voter registration system that, as you can imagine, has not come without implementation issues and delays.

As required by Section 14.001 of the Texas Election Code, the voter registrar is required to issue renewal voter registration certificates on or after November 15 but before December 6 of each odd-numbered year.

At this time, however, the mass mailout feature within the State's voter registration system is not functioning. The Texas Secretary of State's Office is actively working with the system vendor to resolve this issue, along with other system-related concerns and delays.

At this time, the Leon County Elections Department does not have a timeline for when voter registration certificates will be mailed and appreciate the public's patience. "As we prepare for a very active election year, our focus remains on maintaining accurate voter records and upholding the integrity of the election process." As a reminder, an acceptable form of photo id is required to vote (with some exceptions) however you do not have to present a valid voter registration certificate to vote.

Voters are encouraged to contact Leon County Elections Office to verify their voter registration status, residence address, and mailing address information. It is vital that all information on a voter's registration record is accurate, as incorrect residence addresses may cause ballot issuance complications when voters appear at the polls during the upcoming elections.
