

# JOINT POLLING PLACE ELECTION AGREEMENT

For May 3, 2025

Between

Buffalo Independent School District  
and  
City of Buffalo

Ref: House Bill 1, 79<sup>th</sup> Legislature, Third Called Special Session, 2006  
School districts must now have joint polling places on Election Day.

BY TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT, Buffalo Independent School District and the City of Buffalo, do hereby agree, pursuant to the provisions of the Texas Election Code, to hold elections, of the General Board of Trustee Election of the Buffalo Independent School District and the General Election of the City of Buffalo, at a joint polling place, on Saturday, May 3, 2025.

The **“joint polling place election agreement”** refers only to **sharing of the polling place and cost of refreshments** for Buffalo Independent School District General Election and the City of Buffalo General Election on May 3, 2025. The Buffalo Independent School District Election and the City of Buffalo Election shall be held at the **Buffalo Convention Center** located at **812 North Buffalo Avenue** in Buffalo, Texas.

“Entity” refers to the Buffalo Independent School District and the City of Buffalo.

Each entity shall conduct its election separately at the joint polling place. (Buffalo Convention Center)

Each entity shall be responsible for its own election expenses (paper ballots, computer programming for electronic ballots, rental of electronic voting machines, payroll of election workers and other costs common to election expenses).

Each entity shall conduct Early Voting at its normal place of early voting or desired place of early voting for this General Election. (Usually held in the administration office of each entity.)

Buffalo Independent School District agrees to pay the City of Buffalo its share in the cost of refreshments for the election workers at the Convention Center. The City of Buffalo will invoice Buffalo Independent School District for its share of the total cost of refreshments after Election Day.

The joint polling place, Buffalo Convention Center, will be opened at 6 am on Saturday, May 3, 2025, for election workers to prepare for the day.

The joint polling place, Buffalo Convention Center, will open for voting at 7 am.

The joint polling place, Buffalo Convention Center, will close the voting at 7 pm.

The joint polling place will be closed and the door locked after election workers leave the building.
