LEON COUNTY, TEXAS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 251.009 of the Texas Transportation Code, the Leon County Commissioners' Court may authorize and regulate the construction and erection of cattle guards on its county roads regardless of class,

WHEREAS; it is in the best interests of the County, and the county road maintenance system that the Leon County Commissioners' Court control and regulate such construction and placement of cattle guards on its county roads regardless of class, and

WHEREAS; after finding that notice of the proposed authorization has been published according to the law, the Leon County Commissioners' Court hereby adopts the following Cattle Guard Authorization, (Ordinance), to-wit,

I.

Any person or entity who builds, constructs, or erects a cattle guard on any county road of any class in Leon County, Texas commits an offense

An offense hereunder is a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$5 00 or more than \$100 00 Each day the offense exists, it is a separate violation, and subject to a fine as set out above




Further, any cattle guard constructed on a county road of any class after the effective date of this authorization, (Ordinance), set out below shall be deemed to be an obstruction of such county road, and may be removed by the County Any costs and expenses incurred in removing the obstacle shall be reimbursed and paid to the County by the person or entity in violation.


