ORDER NO. <u>CC-2023-13</u> TERMINATING JULY 25, 2023 ORDER PROHIBITING OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Kimble County, on the 25th of July, 2023, issued an Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning for Kimble County, Texas, and;

WHEREAS, this Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning provides that the Commissioners Court of Kimble County delegates and designates the County Judge the authority to determine that circumstances no longer create a public safety hazard requiring a ban on outdoor burning and to terminate the burn ban if appropriate so to do.

NOW THEREFORE, the County Judge determines that circumstances in Kimble County no longer create a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, and the July 25, 2023 Order Prohibiting Outdoor Burning is hereby terminated.
