- 6. Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to accept the order ratifying budget, tax rate, and revenue increase for the 2023-2024 budget. Seconded by Commissioner Burson, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

- 7. Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to adopt the 2023-2024 budget. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered
- 8. Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to propose a tax rate of .00535 Seconded by Commissioner Wellman. Commissioner Wood-Yay, Commissioner Wellman-Yay, Commissioner Francis-Yay, Commissioner Burson-Yay, Judge Cogdell-Yay, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
- 9. Motion was made by Commissioner Francis to schedule a public hearing for the 2023 proposed tax rate for Monday, September 11, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
- 10. Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to approve the bonds for Julie Gamble, Juanita Murrell, and Robert Grant Cato. Seconded by Commissioner Francis, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
- 11. Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to order the November 7, 2023 Constitutional Amendment Election. Seconded by Commissioner Francis, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
- 12. Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to accept the bid from U.S. Roof Shield for courthouse roof repair in the amount of \$33,825. Seconded by Commissioner Burson, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
