On the 11th day of September, 2023, the Commissioner's Court of Briscoe County, Texas convened in a Regular Session at the Courty Courtroom, at the Courthouse in Silverton, Texas, with the following members of the Court present to wit:

Meeting was called to order at 9:06 A.M. by Judge Rank Cogdell.

Open Forum: Judge Cogdell told the court that they would need to appoint a designee to represent our area in the High Plains Public Defenders group in the future. Judge Cogdell also informed the commissioners that the roofing company would be here at the end of the month to begin repairs.

Motion was made by Commissioner Francis to approve the minutes from the August 14th, 2023 regular meeting and the August 28th special meeting as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 4-0 vote, it is so ordered. Commissioner Burson absent at time of vote.

Public Hearing on Proposed Tax Rate-called to order 9:10 A.M. No one attended Adjourned 9:25 A.M.

Commissioner Wood moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of .535, which is effectively a 3.2 % increase in the tax rate. Seconded by Commissioner Francis, vote for Commissioner Wellman-Yay, Commissioner Wood-Yay, Commissioner Francis-Yay, Commissioner Burson-Yay, Judge Cogdell-Yay, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Burson to set the dates and times for regular commissioner's court meetings for 2024 as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Francis, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Discussion of Senate Bill 22 requirements-\$75,000 Sheriff salary and \$45,000 deputy salary will start on October 1, 2023.
