On the 10th day of October, 2023, the Commissioner's Court of Briscoe County, Texas convened in a Regular Session at the Courty Courtroom, at the Courthouse in Silverton, Texas, with the following members of the Court present to wit:

Meeting was called to order at 9:02 A.M. by Judge Rank Cogdell.

Open Forum: Judge Cogdell gave the commissioners their invitations to the SDA donor appreciation reception. Judge Cogdell informed the court that the flag pole was in and ready to install. He also asked the commissioners to get pictures of the completed improvements to roads for the disaster program website.

Motion was made by Commissioner Francis to approve the minutes from the September 11th, 2023 regular meeting as presented. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to accept the bid from Mid-Plains for a new phone system for the courthouse for \$355.00 per month. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to accept the bid from Royal Architectural Products to replace existing door locks on the 3 main doors of the courthouse with keypad entry. The funds in the amount of \$8,405.00 will be taken out of courthouse security. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Discussion on possible interlocal agreement with Bailey County for shared attorney was tabled. Motion by Commissioner Wellman. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to amend the commissioners court calendar for 2023-2024. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood approve the Interlocal Agreement For The Establishment Of The High Plains Regional Public Defender's Office. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to assign Briscoe County's 1150 votes for the Briscoe County Appraisal District Board of Directors equally between each nominee for a total of 310 votes each. Nominees are as follows: Phil Barefield, Billy Rank Cogdell, Larry Comer, Kyle Fuston, and M'Lynn Taylor. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Francis to approve the 2024 Briscoe County Resolution for the Indigent Defense Grant Program. Seconded by Commissioner Wood, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Francis to table the discussion on a bid from RES for floodlights and electrical work related to courthouse security and the flagpole. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wellman to let Sheriff Davis begin the process of looking for a new patrol vehicle, a ¾ or ½ ton being acceptable. Seconded by Commissioner Francis, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.

Motion was made by Commissioner Wood to let Sheriff Davis start advertising for a 4th deputy sheriff. Seconded by Commissioner Wellman, passed with a 5-0 vote, it is so ordered.
