

Affidavit of Driver's Safety

This affidavit is used for requesting permission to take a Driver's Safety Course, if applicable.

AFFIDAVIT

I SWEAR OR AFFIRM THAT:

- I have a valid non-commercial Texas driver's license or permit,
- I have proof of a valid vehicle insurance policy or proof of financial responsibility, listing me as a covered driver,
- I am not in the process of taking a Driver's Safety Course (Under Section 45.0511 CCP) and I have not completed a Driver's Safety Course that is not showing on my driving record within the last 12 months preceding the date of the offense.

I WAIVE MY RIGHT TO A TRIAL BY JUDGE OR JURY, enter a plea of NO CONTEST, and understand that I have 90 DAYS from the date of the affidavit to take an approved course and submit the certificate of completion along with a copy of my driving record to the court. Either the certified (version 3A) or the non-certified (version 3) is acceptable. I understand that failure to complete within 90 days from the date of this affidavit, may result in an appearance before a judge to show cause for not complying with the terms set forth by the court.
