 - 1) the County is not responsible for the maintenance, repair, or upkeep of any road within a subdivision
 - 2) any subdivision plans must meet all state and federal regulations for sewer and water. A permit or certificate shall be provided.
 - 3) no signs, posts, or dumpsters may be placed in the right-of-way
 - 4) no water, electrical, communication, gas, or other utility line may be placed in the right of way without prior approval of the Commissioner's Court,
 - 5) Any cut or damage to a county road must be repaired or replaced, in the same condition prior to work being done on right of way and
 - 6) any line for the use of a utility installed underground must be at least 48 inches below the bottom of the ditch and completely enclosed in a steel casing
6. Discuss and approve application for Round IX Grant
7. Consider and act upon Burn Ban (90 days)
8. Consider and act upon budget amendments
9. Approve County Finance Report
10. Approve Bonds

11. Sheriff 's Office to give report
12. Approve and pay claims against the County
13. Discuss any other items pertaining to County Business or public comment; for information purposes only, no action may be taken on these items except to schedule them for future agenda.
