   Judge Keyes called the meeting to order with a prayer and pledges of allegiance.

Esmeralda Felan, Auditor, stated the ArchiveSocial annual invoice for \$2,388 and The Golf System Inc. annual invoice for \$1,550 needed to be paid. Commissioner Rosson made a motion to authorize the auditor the pay the ArchiveSocial & The Gold Systems invoices as presented. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.   - Judge Keyes stated Judge Filley, District Judge requested the Civic Building be designated as an alternative court location for jury selections, trials in person with social distancing etc. Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve the Civic Building as an alternative court location. Commissioner Murphree seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Consider approving the Sheriff to accept a gift from the PBRPC; take action as appropriate Judge Keyes stated the PBRPC had declared a 16 Channel recorder as surplus and wanted to present to the Sheriff's office as a gift. Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve the gift from PBRPC to the Sherriff's office. Commissioner Rosson seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

  - Commissioner Rosson made a motion to approve changing the hours for the Seminole and Seagraves Librarys to 8:30a.m.-5:30p.m. as discussed with Sabra Hall. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Consider approving update for vehicle code computers for Precincts; take action as appropriate Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve Noregon Systems Inc. to update the vehicle code for all Precincts in the amount of \$2,123.94 and the auditor to issue a demand check for payment. Commissioner Murphree seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)

Consider signing an Interlocal Agreement with the Regional Public Defender Office Local Government Corporation to provide the level of indigent services previously provided by the Regional Public Defender Office for Capital Cases (RPDO) to represent indigent capital murder defendants in Gaines County; take action as appropriate

  - Commissioner Belt made a motion to approve the contract with Win Supply Rain Bird Dealer for 3 years with a one time payment of \$7,342.65. Commissioner Murphree seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)
- 8. Consider authorizing the County Judge to sign a permit authorizing Basin Oil and Gas to perform a 3D geophysical survey on 15 acres owned by Gaines County, legal description LGE 311 NE/15AC LBR I GAINES CSL; take action as appropriate
  - Commissioner Houston stated he required the language to be added to the ppermit that the distance from water wells be 300-400 feet away in League 311 NE/15AC Labor 1. Judge Keyes will change the language and update the permit. Commissioner Houston made a motion to authorize Basin Oil and Gas to perform a 3D geophysical survey with the language update. Commissioner Murphree seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)
- 9. Discussion and consider taking potential action regarding all issues deemed necessary or desired at this time by the Commissioners Court for the County response to the pending COVID-19 emergency, including:

However, employees in offices with plexi glass are not required to wear mask at their desk while practicing social distancing. Commissioner Murphree seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

Commissioner Rosson made a motion to approved Disaster Declaration #19 Order #01-1124-20 as presented following the Governors recommendations. Commissioner Belt seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. (see attached)
