The Matagorda County Emergency Operation Center will have a Facebook live event Monday May 18, 2020 at 5PM. It will be on our MCEOC Facebook page.

Today Sunday May 17th the MCHD officials are reporting no new positive case of COVID-19.

There was no report from the Palacios Community Medical Center.

Our county total is 66 positive cases, of which 37 are recovered and 5 have passed away. Matagorda County's number of active cases is now 24.
