The Matagorda County Emergency Operation Center was informed this afternoon that the Matagorda County Hospital District Officials received confirmation that a man between the ages of 90 and 100 passed away with symptoms consistent with COVID-19.

The patient's COVID-19 status was confirmed in an outpatient setting prior to being admitted to the Matagorda Regional Medical Center for care. The man was later transferred to a healthcare facility in Victoria where he passed away. This is the fifth confirmed COVID-19 related death of a Matagorda County resident.
