EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

Under general supervision, utilize skills of average complexity in the performance of a variety of semi-skilled and skilled tasks in the construction, maintenance and repair of roads and bridges and related facilities. Responsible for the safe and efficient operation of trucks and equipment in the construction and general maintenance of county roads and bridges; patches and overlays roads with asphalt; operates heavy rollers, motor graders, backhoe, track loaders and other equipment in preparing road beds and finishing road surfaces; services and makes minor repairs to all trucks and equipment; performs manual labor as part of the regular work assignment.

DESIRABLE QUALIFICATIONS:

High School diploma or GED; one year of experience in construction; knowledge of the traffic laws, ordinances and regulations involved in the safe operation of equipment. Must be self-motivated and willing to accept varied assignments. Ability to understand and follow oral and/or written instructions, ability to perform labor tasks under any type of weather conditions. Must be able to work in the event of an emergency. Class A CDL license required. Must have a good driving record. Must be able to pass a drug test.
