DECLARING A LOCAL STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Robertson beginning on the 17th day of May, 2021 has suffered severe storms and heavy rain, damage to property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from wide spread weather conditions. The result of rolling power outages and associated water shortages have also led to widespread property damage and dangerous conditions for Robertson County residents.

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Emergency Management has issued incident #21-0011 for the mitigation and support of areas affected.

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Robertson County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect or rehabilitate property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF ROBERTSON COUNTY:

- 1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for the County of Robertson.
- 2. That the County's inter-jurisdictional Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
- 3. That this State of Disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of the County of Robertson, Texas.
- 4. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
