NOTICE OF INTENT TO PERMANENTLY ABANDON, CLOSE AND VACATE A PORTION OF ROBERTSON COUNTY ROAD 453, ALSO KNOWN AS KROWINBERGER ROAD

Pursuant to Chapter 251 of the Texas Transportation Code, notice is hereby given that after the expiration of twenty (20) days from the date of the posting hereof, LUMINANT MINING COMPANY LLC and LUMINANT GENERATION COMPANY LLC, landowners of the property adjoining that certain portion of Robertson County Road 453, will file and present to the Commissioners Court of Robertson County, Texas, an application and petition to permanently abandon, close and vacate a portion of Robertson County Road 453, also known as Krowinberger Road, located in Precinct No. 4, Robertson County, Texas, as more particularly described on the Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
